## RECAP Remembering past Commodore Skip Carpenter



Charles "Skip" Carpenter Jr., was laid to rest on November 5, 2025 at the Miramar National Cemetery, born August 21, 1934 in Boston, to Rear Admiral Charles and Dorothy Carpenter. He was commissioned into the United States Marine Corps as a 2<sup>nd</sup> lieutenant upon graduation from the University of Virginia. He was a member of the Phi Delta Theta Fraternity. Received his Masters Degree from the Naval Postgraduate School, after retiring from the Marines he went on to a successful career in Quality Assurance,


While stationed in Honolulu, he met the love of his life Bonnie, a stewardess also based there. They were married for 60 glorious years.

Awarded the Bronze Star, Skip's life is one you only read about in books. He traveled to over 100 countries. The cruise ship became his home away from home.

The ocean was Skip's second home, and he was an avid sailor and fisherman. He was an active member of the Coronado, Santa Margarita (Past Commodore), and La Playa Yacht Clubs.

A Patron of the arts, he was also a connoisseur of the drink, finding like minded comrades with his association to The La Jolla Wine & Food and Chaines des Rotisseurs Societies.

He is survived by his three children: Camie, Chad (Maureen), and Cort. Six grandchildren: Taylor (Brad), Cole, Connor (Addy), Andria, Sebastian, Mia, and great grandson Greyson, along with his sister, Olivia Salzberg.

# If You're Ever Under the Helo:

To prepare a boat for US Coast Guard helicopter rescue operations, follow these guidelines:

### FOLLOWING THESE STEPS CAN HELP ENSURE A SUCCESSFUL AND SAFE RESCUE OPERATION

#### Ensure Safety:

Make sure all passengers wear life jackets and stow loose items that could be caught by the helicopter's rotor blades.

#### Communicate:

Tune your VHF Marine radio to channel 16 and ensure it's on and the volume is up. Establish clear communication with the helicopter.

#### Prepare for Approach:

Lower antenna masts and secure sails if you're on a sailboat. The helicopter pilot will approach into the wind to enhance visibility.

#### Maintain Course:

Keep the boat heading and speed as directed by the helicopter pilot. Ensure the boat is stable and can maintain course until the rescue is complete.

#### Be Prepared:

Have a detailed pre-underway briefing with the helicopter crew to discuss goals, signals, and safety procedures.
