The Ladies Day Championship Trophy

This trophy is deeded to the Santa Margarita Yacht Club, a recognized member of the United States Naval Sailing Association of Annapolis, the San Diego Association of Yacht Clubs, and the Southern California Association of Yacht Clubs. The club is located at the Del Mar Marina, at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, in Oceanside, California.

Whereas a central objective of the club is to encourage and foster recreational and competitive boating, this trophy is hereby deeded by Thomas and Glenda Gardner to the Santa Margarita Yacht Club to commemorate annually the winning crew of the Ladies Day Races to be held each year at the Camp Pendleton, Del Mar Marina.

The trophy shall be known as the Ladies Day Championship Trophy and is deeded under the following terms and conditions:

- 1) The trophy shall be a perpetual trophy awarded at the conclusion of the day's events and at the Club's Annual Banquet.
- 2) The trophy shall be in the custody and control of the Santa Margarita Yacht Club and displayed in the Club's clubhouse.
- 3) All crew members participating in the race shall be female.
- All crews participating in the race shall be skippered by a female member of the Santa Margarita Yacht Club.
- 5) The first crew to be recognized are the winners of the 2013 event.
- 6) The name of each crew member (2) of the winning boat shall be engraved on the trophy with the name of the skipper first.
- 7) In the event that the annual race is permanently cancelled the trophy shall be returned to the donors or their successors if reasonably possible.
- 8) Any and all changes in the dedication of this trophy will require the advice of the majority of female club members and approval of the Board of Directors of the Santa Margarita Yacht Club.
