JANUARY

2 Chronicles 7:14

"If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land."

FEBRUARY

1 John 5:14

"Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us"

MARCH

Matthew 26:36a, 39b

"Then Jesus came with them to a place called Gethsemane... and prayed, saying: O My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as You will."

APRIL

Psalms 69:13

"But as for me, my prayer is to you, O Lord. At an acceptable time, O God, in the abundance of Your steadfast love answer me in Your saving faithfulness" (ESV)

MAY

James 5:16

"Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous person (man) avails much."

JUNE

Hebrews 4:16

"Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need."

JULY

Psalms 66:19

"But truly God has listened; He has attended to the voice of my prayer." (ESV)

AUGUST

Ephesians 6:18

"And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people." (NIV)

SEPTEMBER

Mark 11:22, 24

"So Jesus answered and said to them have faith in God. Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them."

OCTOBER

Psalms 55:16-17

"As for me, I will call upon God, and the Lord shall save me. Evening, and morning, and at noon I will pray, and cry aloud, and He shall hear my voice."

NOVEMBER

Philippians 4:6-7

"Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." (NIV)

DECEMBER

Romans 12:12

"Constantly rejoicing in hope [because of our confidence in Christ], steadfast and patient in distress, devoted to prayer [continually seek wisdom, guidance, and strength]." (AMP)
