- 6) Virgin – in Hebrew “Almah” means – young maiden, or young woman
- 7) Mary is residing in Nazareth of Galilee
- 8) Conceive and give birth to a Son
- 9) Upon hearing the message of GOD from the angel, Mary goes to visit her cousin Elizabeth – hearing that she is also having a baby
- 10) Joseph
- 11) Joseph has a dream “an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, “Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins.” (Matthew 1:20-21)
