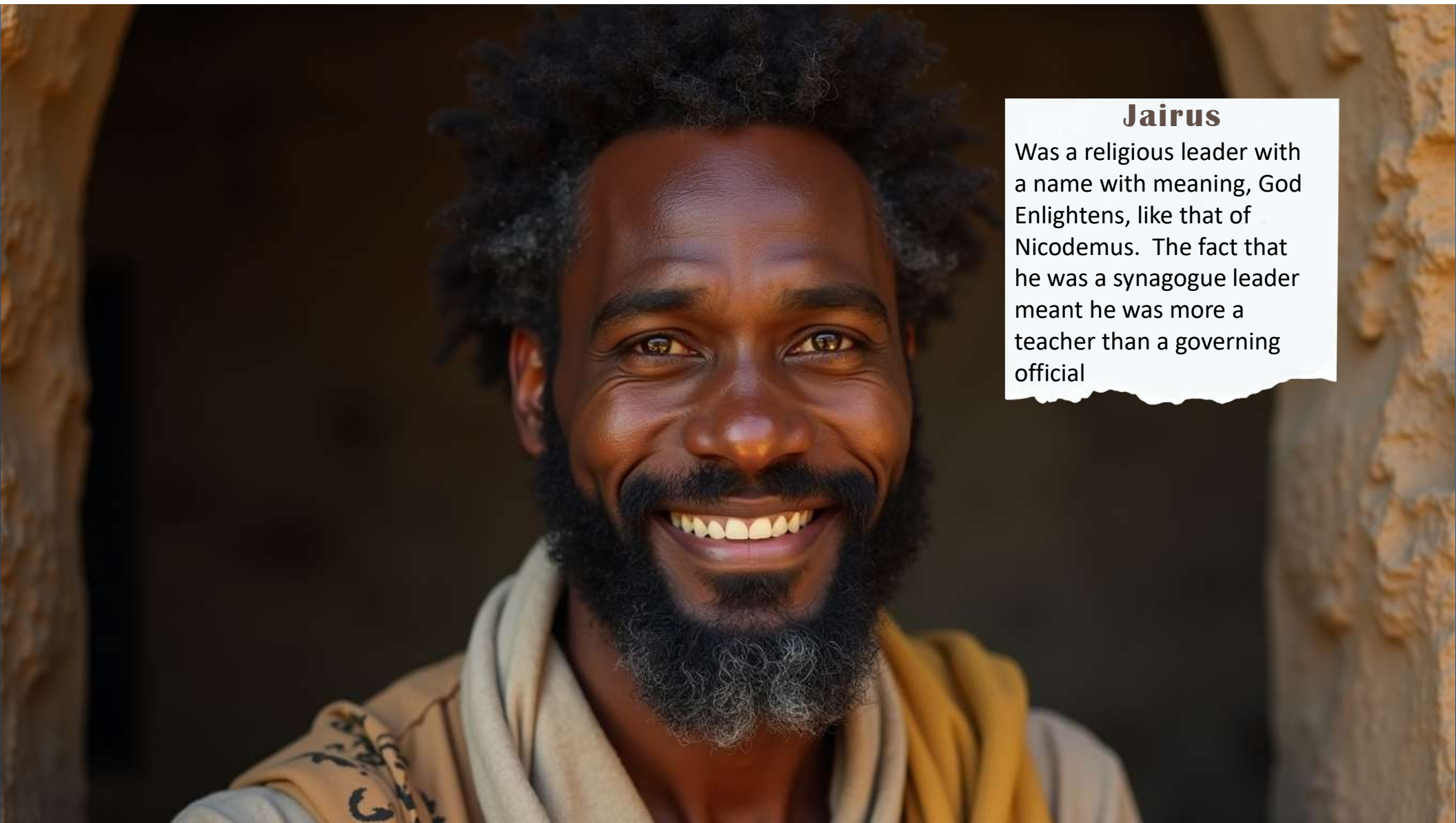

## **Mark 5**

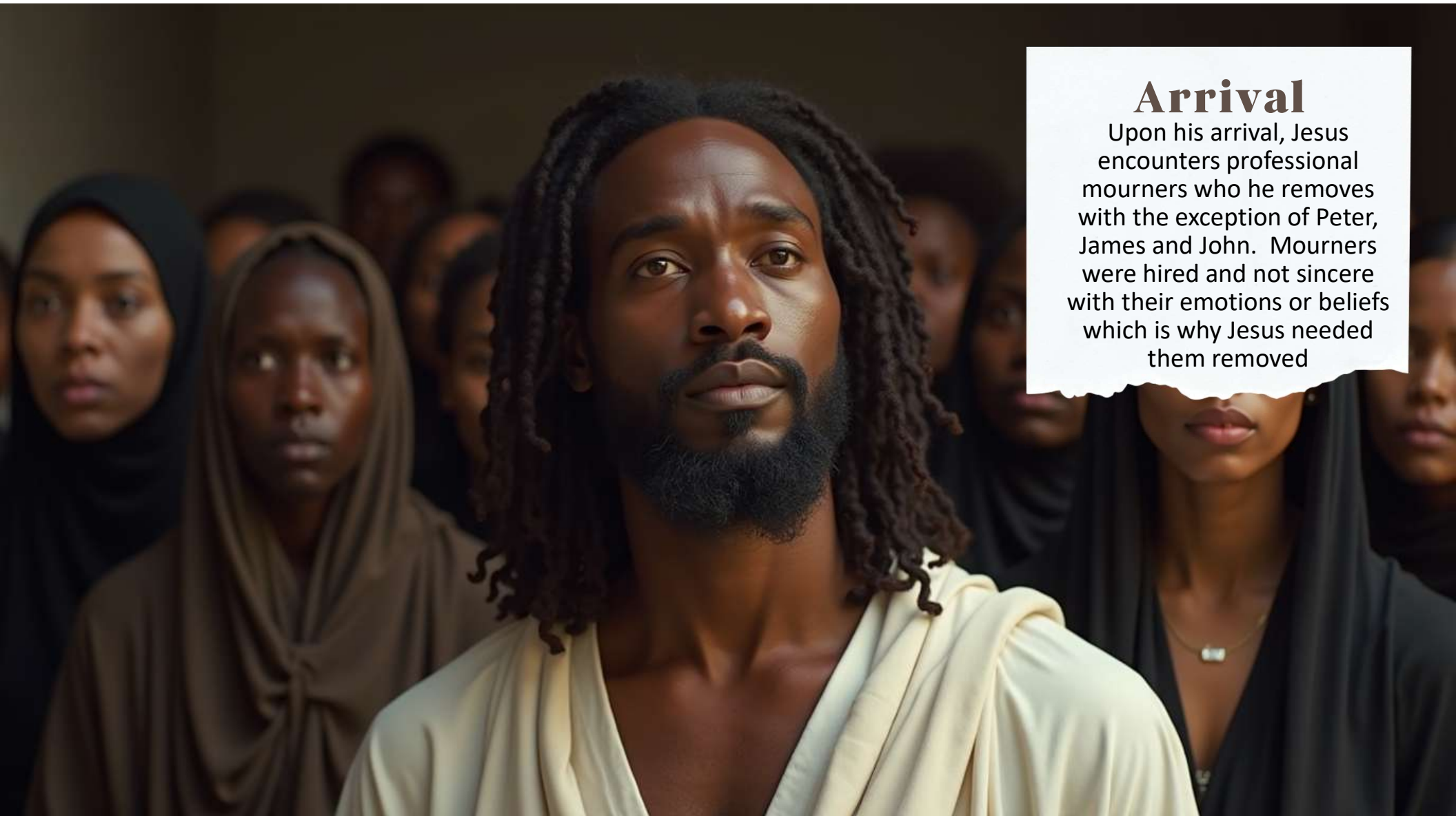
Begins with a return from the Sea of Galilee to a crowd where a woman who had suffered 12 years pressed through the crowd to see Jesus





## **Jairus**

Was a religious leader with a name with meaning, God Enlightens, like that of Nicodemus. The fact that he was a synagogue leader meant he was more a teacher than a governing official



## Arrival

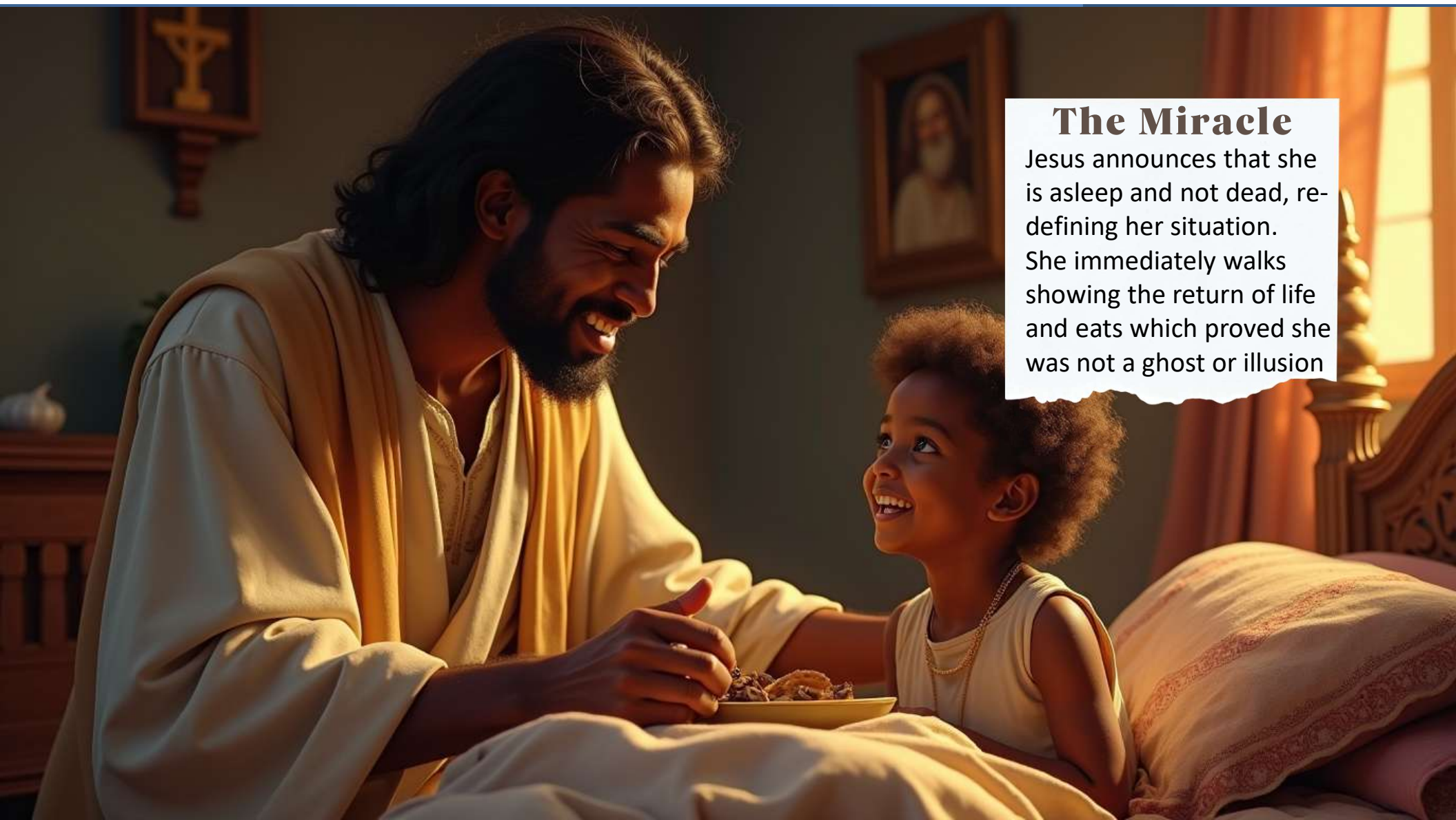
Upon his arrival, Jesus encounters professional mourners who he removes with the exception of Peter, James and John. Mourners were hired and not sincere with their emotions or beliefs which is why Jesus needed them removed



## **The Healing**

Jesus took her by the hand, according to Levitical law it may be one unclean to touch a dead corpse. Notice that Mark switches from Greek to Aramaic in the text





## **The Miracle**

Jesus announces that she is asleep and not dead, re-defining her situation. She immediately walks showing the return of life and eats which proved she was not a ghost or illusion
