Introduction

- Many years ago, there was a preacher of a large church. (Matthew Mead, 1630-1699)
- He wrote that the most dangerous thing on the face of the earth was an "almost Christian".
- What we need to learn is how not to be one.
- We need full-blown genuine Christians.



- We are not talking about those who almost became a Christian.
- Acts 26:28 Agrippa said "almost thou persuadest me to be a Christian.
- Some have not made that commitment to live for Jesus.
- But there are some who said they would live for Jesus, but they do not do it.

Introduction

The Wheat And The Tares

- Matthew 13:24-30
- Some want to call this the parable of religious tolerance because the master was not willing to possibly hurt the good wheat.
- Our focus is upon those tares that are among the church.
- These are our "almost-Christians".

How To Be An Almost Christian

- **1. Live somewhat worldly, just not worldly enough to get kicked out of church.**
- 2. A "tare" could speak evil of others, even railing against some without much fear of being expelled from the church.
- If a gossiper has ever been withdrawn from it has to be quite rare.
- A crafty "tare" here could be pretty safe.
 Never contribute either money or talent.

How To Be An Almost Christian

- Nobody will really ever know whether you give according to how you have prospered – you know, that thing about the right and left hands (Matthew 6:3).
- 4. You never need to teach an alien sinner the way of salvation.
- Almost-Christians just don't do that.
- 5. You really never need to assist any suffering person, whether they are Christians or not.
- Tares don't do that either.
- We could add so much more to this list.



The Great Battle

- The Lord's church has always been fighting this battle.
- There will always be those who are not fully committed to the Lord,
- And there will be those who show no zeal for the work of God.
- Our concern has to be to not allow them to influence us to turn away from God.



Conclusion

- Almost persuaded, almost but lost.
- Almost Christians are not real or genuine.
- They do more harm to the work of the Church than anyone else, even the enemies of God.
- Titus 1:16 speaks of these.
- As in the parable, these will be gathered up on that last day and cast into the fire.
