Our choices have consequences


- While we may recognize that we have choices, and we are the ones to make those choices, there are doctrines of men that eliminate choices for us.

- There are many different teachings and understandings of Calvinism.


 The main points or tenets of Calvinism remove all choices from mankind, and place everything into God's hands.

 The problem with this teaching is that God has given us things whereby we must choose to do or not do something.


 And by either doing or not doing, God will decide to punish or reward.

In other words---make up your minds.


Proverbs 1:29 "Because they hated knowledge And did not choose the fear of the LORD",

Proverbs 12:26 "The righteous should choose his friends carefully, For the way of the wicked leads them astray".


Deuteronomy 30:15 "See, I have set before you today life and death, good and evil",


