

THE POWER OF CORPORATE PRAYER

ACIS 12:1-19

And he went out and followed him. And he did not know that this happening throughthe angel was true, but thought he saw a vision.






Act 12:12 <u>And thinking about it</u>, he came to the house of Mary the mother of John, whose last name was Mark; where many had gathered together to pray.

Act 12:17 But, waving to them with his hand to be quiet, he declared to


them how the Lord had brought him out of the prison. And he said, Go tell these things to James and to the brothers. And he departed and went into another place.




