It should be remembered that Chapter 6 closes with the disciples of Jesus having been awarded their own basket following the feeding of the five thousand

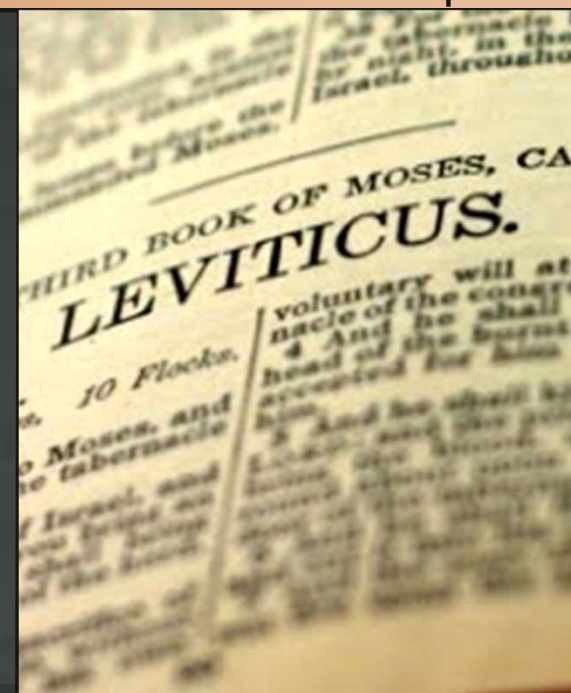
Permit me to remind  
you that the group  
from Jerusalem are  
already at odds



with the ministry  
of Jesus, as they  
had been with  
John the Baptist



The complaints of the group is based upon the "Holiness Code" that is found in the book of Leviticus



To be sure, the group from Jerusalem is not suggesting that the disciples were guilty of eating foods forbidden by the Book of Leviticus



**In contrast, the foods  
in question are  
allowed but  
seemingly polluted by  
the unwashed hands  
of the disciples**





Rather than defend the hands of the disciples, Jesus points to the hypocrisy of the group by going back to the Book of Leviticus



Jesus quotes Isaiah, the same book used by John the Baptist, to suggest that their criticism is based upon human tradition and not God's commandments

5th Commandment:  
**HONOR YOUR  
FATHER AND MOTHER**


More specifically Jesus calls attention to the commandment to "honor thy father and thy mother"



Corban was a human tradition that pretended to love God more than anything else, included family

In reality they used "corban" to hold on to their riches and not take care of their elderly parents
