

# The First Plague - Water Turned into Blood


- The Nile River and all water sources turned into blood

# The Second Plague - Frogs








- Frogs infested Egypt, covering the land

## The Third Plague - Gnats



Gnats swarmed Egypt,causing irritation anddiscomfort

## The Fourth Plague - Flies

•Flies invaded Egypt, causing widespread nuisance

perished






### The Tenth Plague - Death of the Firstborn




Describe the tenth and final plague
