- 2) What is the penalty of sin?
Death or eternal separation from God.
- 3) How do we become saved?
By belief of faith in Jesus Christ as God's Son and savior of the world.
- 4) What separates us from fellowship with God?
Sin.
- 5) Who are the members of the Trinity?
God the Father, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit.
- 6) What is the first ordinance of the church?
The first ordinance is Baptism.
- 7) Baptists believe in what type of baptism?
Full immersion baptism.

Greek. (Baptizo – fully in the water, immerse)
- 10) What does water baptism signify?
Our identification with Christ in His death, burial and resurrection. We believe we die to old sinful nature and arise or come up in newness of life.
- 11) What is the second ordination of the church?
The Lord's Supper.
- 12) What does the grape juice or wine represent?
It represent His spilled blood.

13) What does the wafer, bread represent?

It represent His broken body.

14) Do we take the bread and wine as literal or symbolic?

We believe in the symbolic practice of sharing in the Lord's Supper.

15) How many books are in the Bible?

There are 66 books in the Bible.

16) How many are in the Old Testament?

There are 39 books in the Old Testament.

17) How many are in the New Testament?

There are 27 books in the NT.

18) Name the categories of the Old Testament?

The 5 Categories are Law, History, Poetry, Major Prophets, Minor Prophets.

19) Name the categories of the NT?

The 4 Categories are Gospels, History, Letters/Epistles and Prophecy
