- 2) Name the first woman mentioned in the Bible where is her story found? Eve
- 3) Name the Old Testament woman who learned that there is nothing impossible for God, she was advanced in age and barren; unable to have children, yet God showed His power, and fulfilled His promise and she later gave birth? Sarah
- 4) Named the OT woman of valor who listened to the voice of God and led the people of Israel during the times of the judges. **Deborah**
- 5) Name the OT woman who showed remarkable faith in God and prayed fervently for God to give her a child, that she later dedicated back to God. Hannah
- 6) Name the OT woman who teaches us how to love well a loving and loyal woman, whose faith in God grew because of her relationship with her mother-in-law. Ruth
- 7) Name the OT woman that was fearless and full of faith. Her courage saved the spies and because of her action, God protected and saved her and her family from destruction. Rahab
- 8) Name the OT woman who rejoiced, danced, and praised God, over His deliverance of the people of Israel from the Egyptian army. **Miriam**
- 9) Name the OT woman who was cast out by her mistress and left to perish but God showed her that He is no respecter of person and blessed her with a son and a legacy. Hagar
- 10) Name the OT woman who showed great courage, and boldness, at the expense of her own life and paid an uninvited visit to the king. **Esther**

- 17) Name the NT woman who was old and barren, yet God opened her womb, and she gave birth to a son whose ministry would include the preaching of repentance and preparing the people's hearts to receive the Messiah. **Elizabeth**
- 18) Name the sister from Bethany whose love and devotion to Jesus is shown in her willingness to sit at his feet. Mary of Bethany

- 19) Name the NT woman who was a benefactor and sponsor of the early church and the Apostle Paul, who commended her for her role as a leader, a deacon. **Phoebe**
- 20) Name the servant girl, an unsung hero of the early church, who interrupted a prayer meeting to insist that the Apostle Peter was at the door, and perhaps saved his life. **Rhoda**
