Pentecost changed him greatly – where he would later show much courage, strength and aptitude – a solid individual, empowered by the Holy Spirit to do great work in the early church

Lessons we can learn from him -God can use anybody! It is better to be a follower who fails than one who fails to follow God's faithfulness can compensate for our times of unfaithfulness We may not always get it right - but we shouldn't give up or give in God can restore us to a place of prominence and favor His strengths – He was a recognized leader of the disciples; one of the inner circle of Jesus; the first great voice of the gospel during and after Pentecost; wrote two Epistles (1st and 2nd Peter); had great enthusiasm for the work of ministry. Peter – The Disciple, Apostle, Teacher, Preacher, Church Father and Leader, Servant and Martyr "And I also say that you are Peter and on this rock I will build My church and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it." Mathew 16:18 What was the "rock" Jesus said he would build His church upon? Think about it: after our study of Peter – has your initial opinion of him change?
