




**The Bible that we currently have is the result of a process that was used by the early church to determine what books would make up the Bible**

consideration**


**The books omitted from the canon are referred to as the "Apocryphal New Testament"**




DO NOT CONFUSE

**Some of the books that make up the Apocryphal New Testament include: The Gospel of James, The Gospel of Mary, The Gospel of Judas to name a few**
