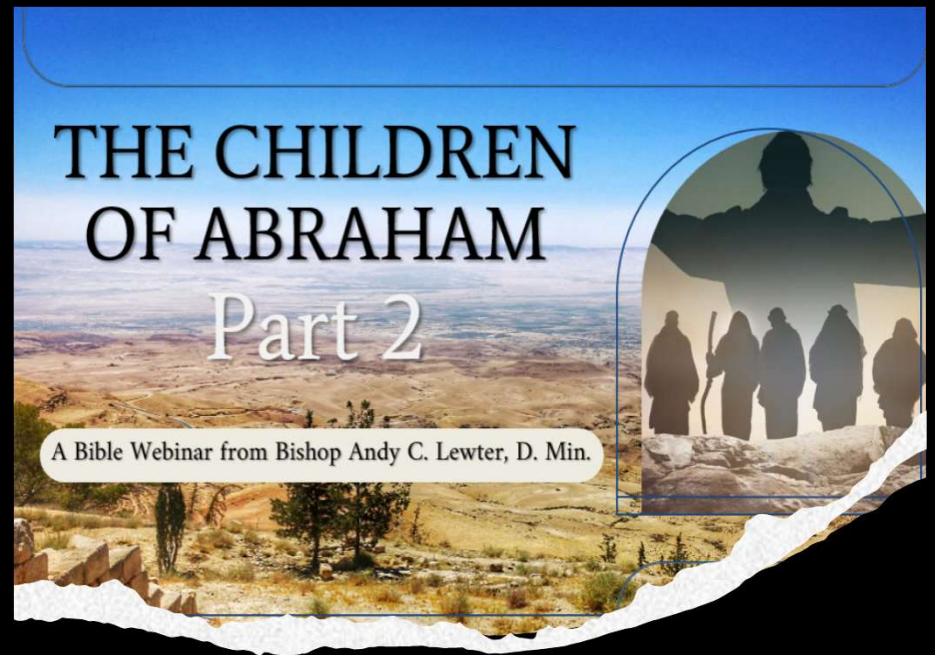




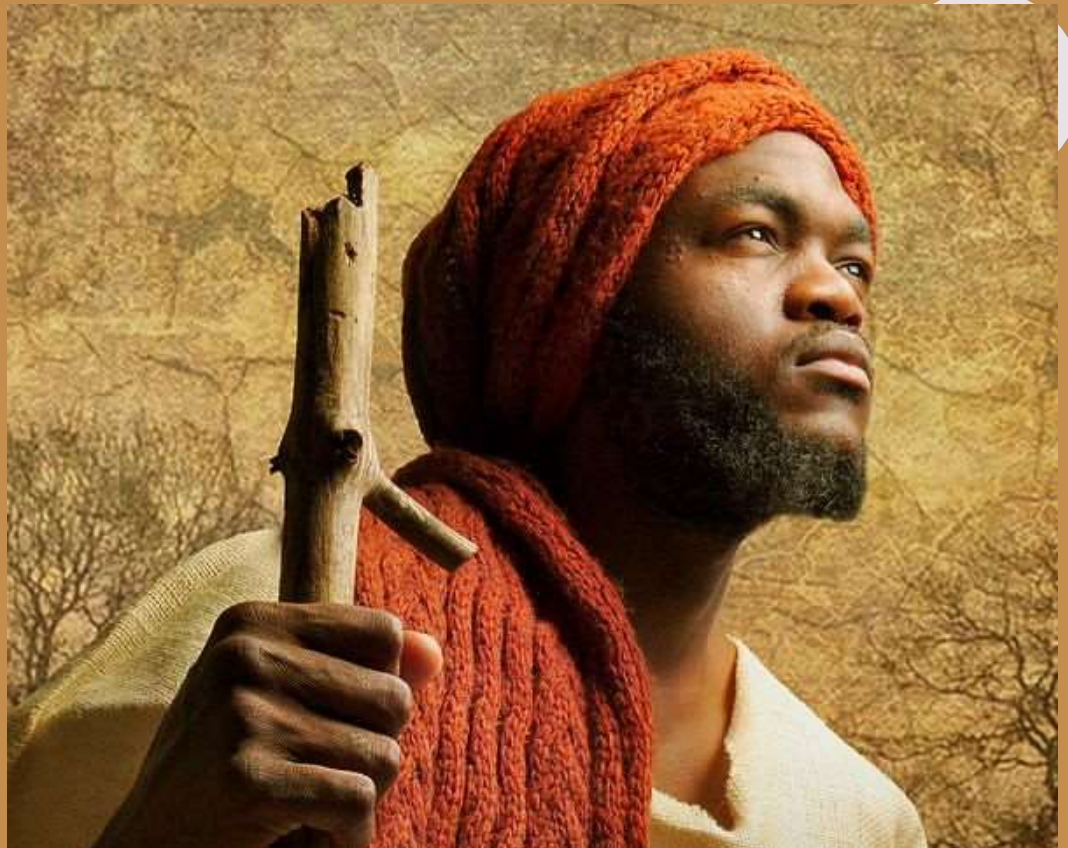

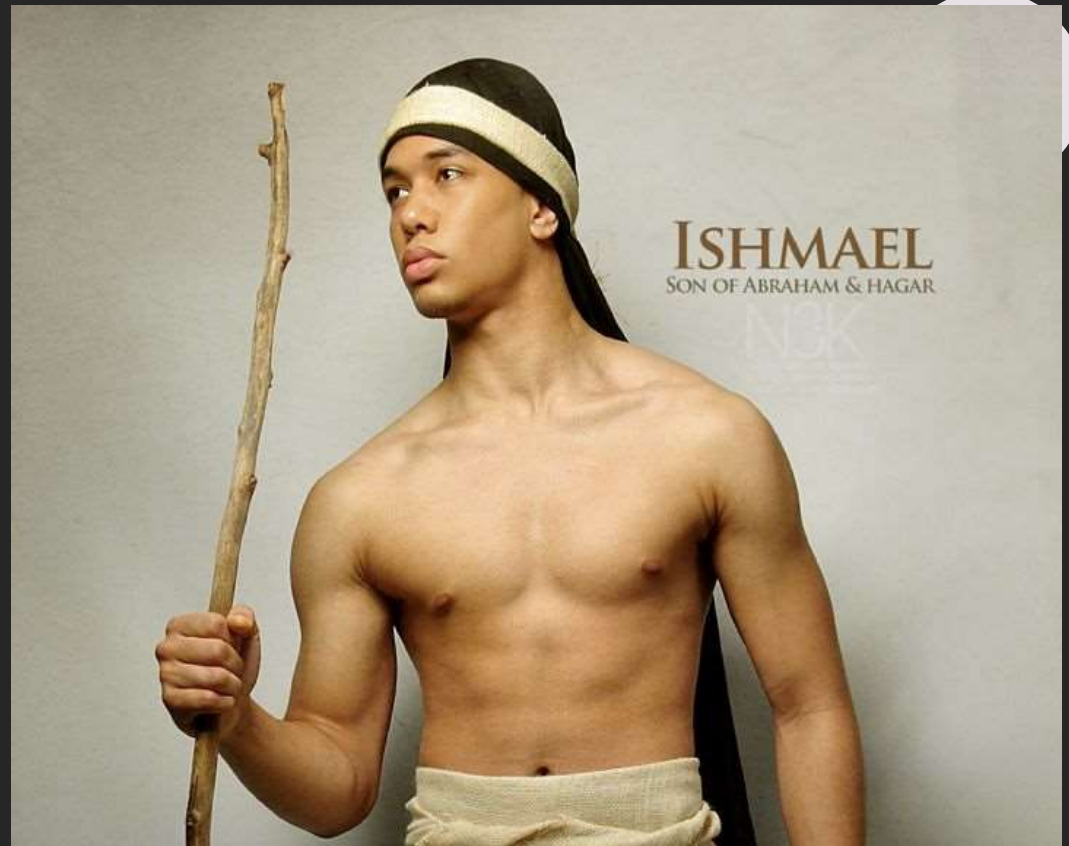
This is the fourth installment on my series about the children of Abraham



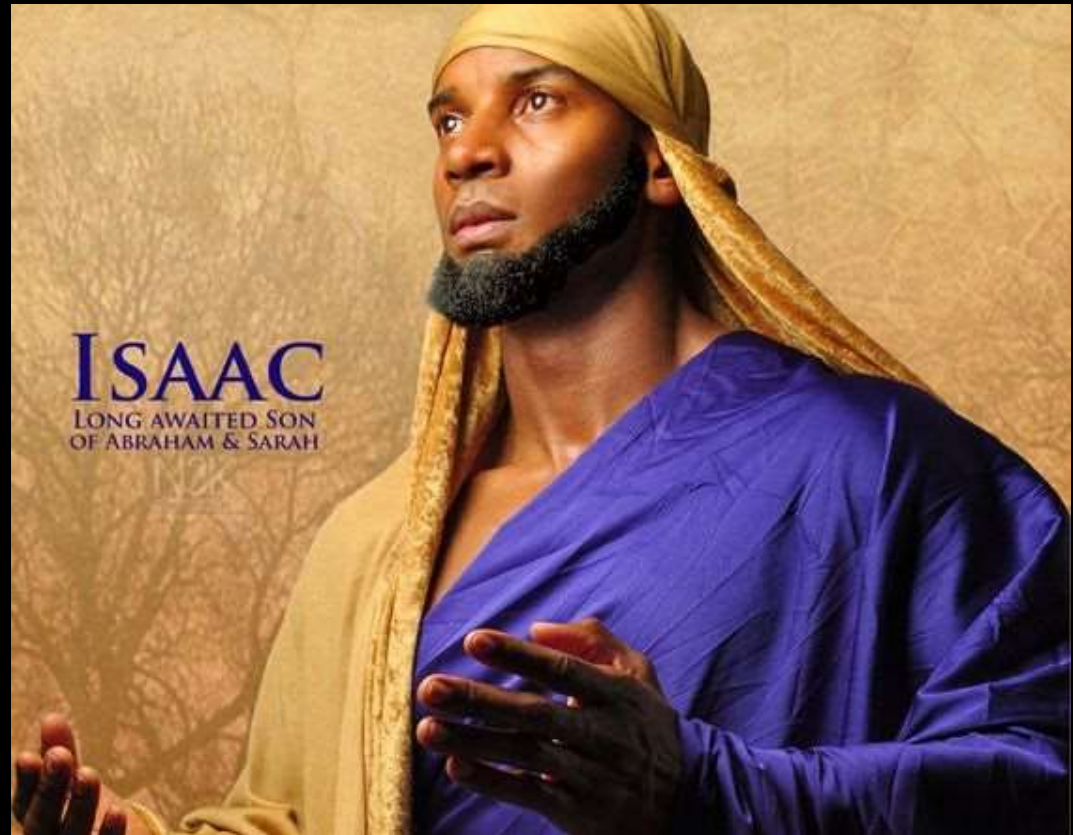
In previous weeks we have discussed the children of Abraham via his descendents of Lot, his adopted son and nephew, who would have been Ammnon and Moab.




In the next lesson we examined the children of Ishmael, the first-born son to Abraham, who included 12 sons and two daughters

Sarah**

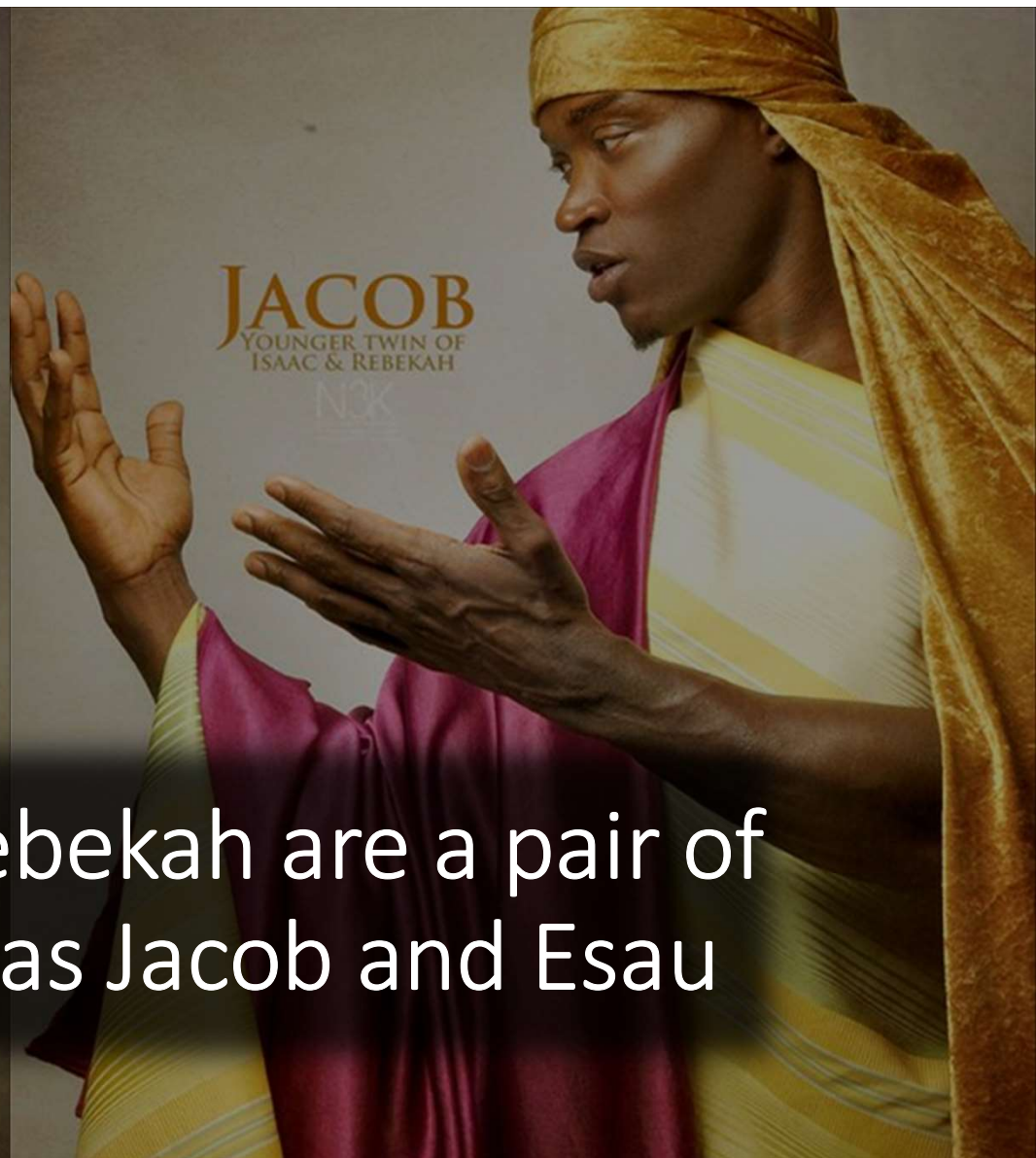




As Christians this is the portion of the family tree that we are concerned with because it includes the blessing and birthright



Before getting to the children let's remember that the wife of Isaac is Rebekah who was the daughter of Nahor and Milchor.



Born to Issac and Rebekah are a pair of twins known to us as Jacob and Esau



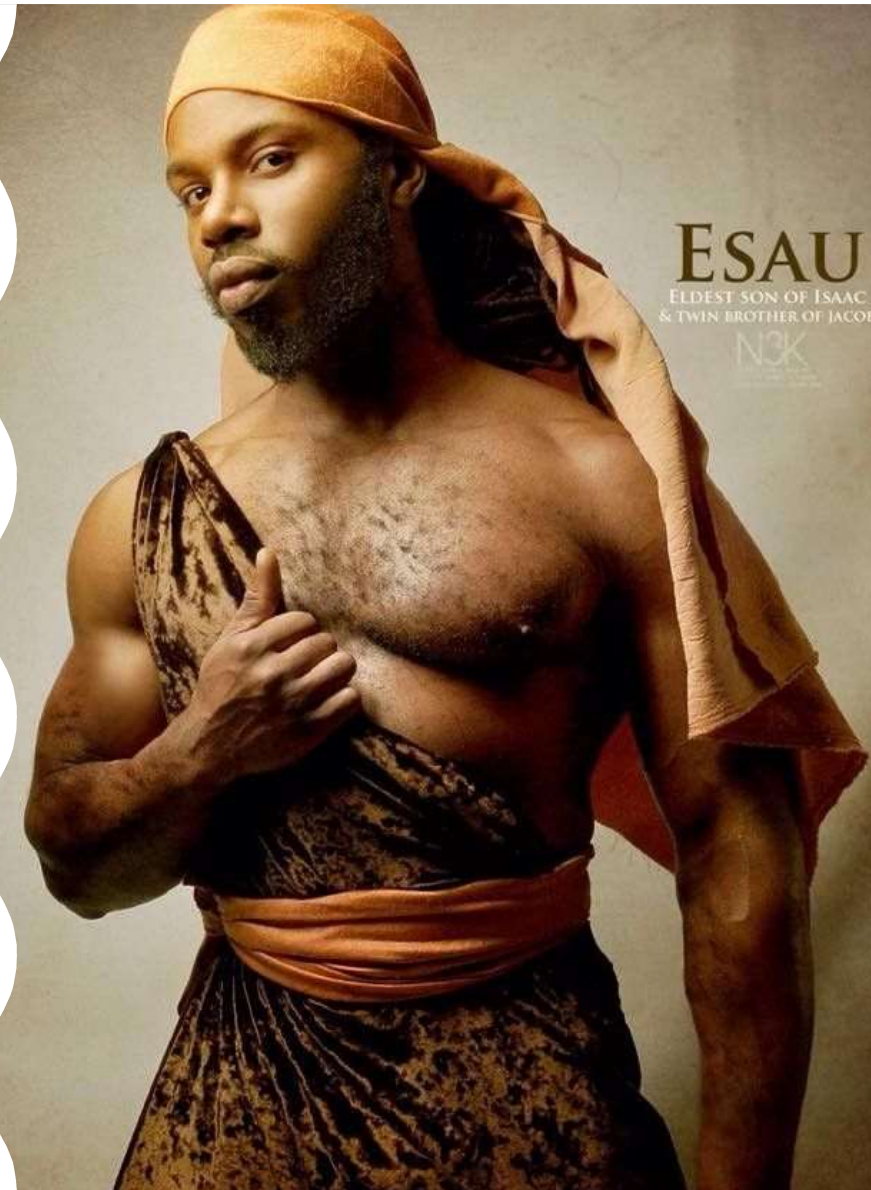

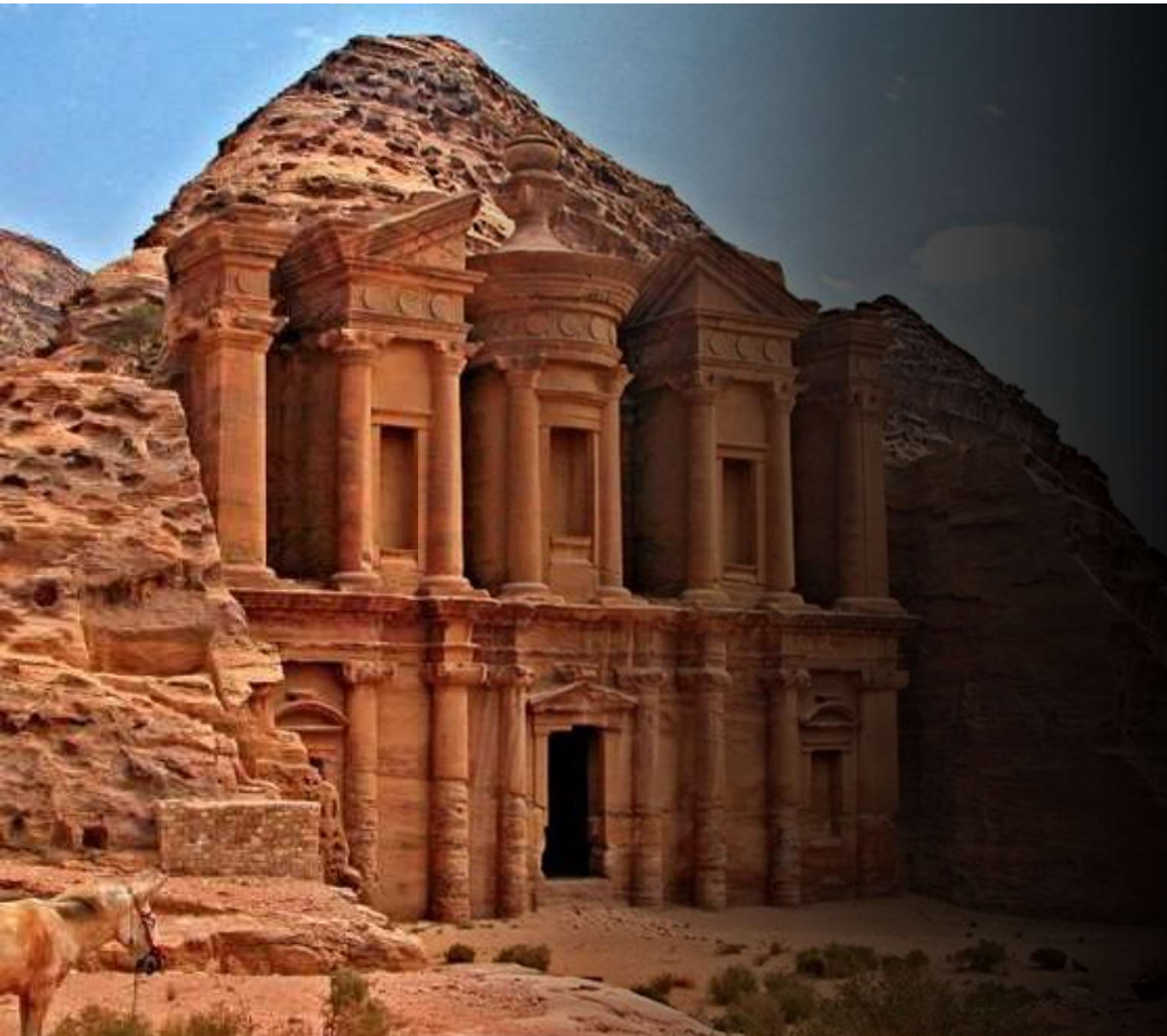
Actually, of the two, Esau is the older of two and here we find the story of Jacob having stolen both the blessings and birthright

In this particular lesson, we are focusing upon the descendants of Esau who would have been the great grandchildren of Abraham




Esau is the father of the "Edomites", which is confirmed in the Hebrew literature that is known to us as the Tanakh.



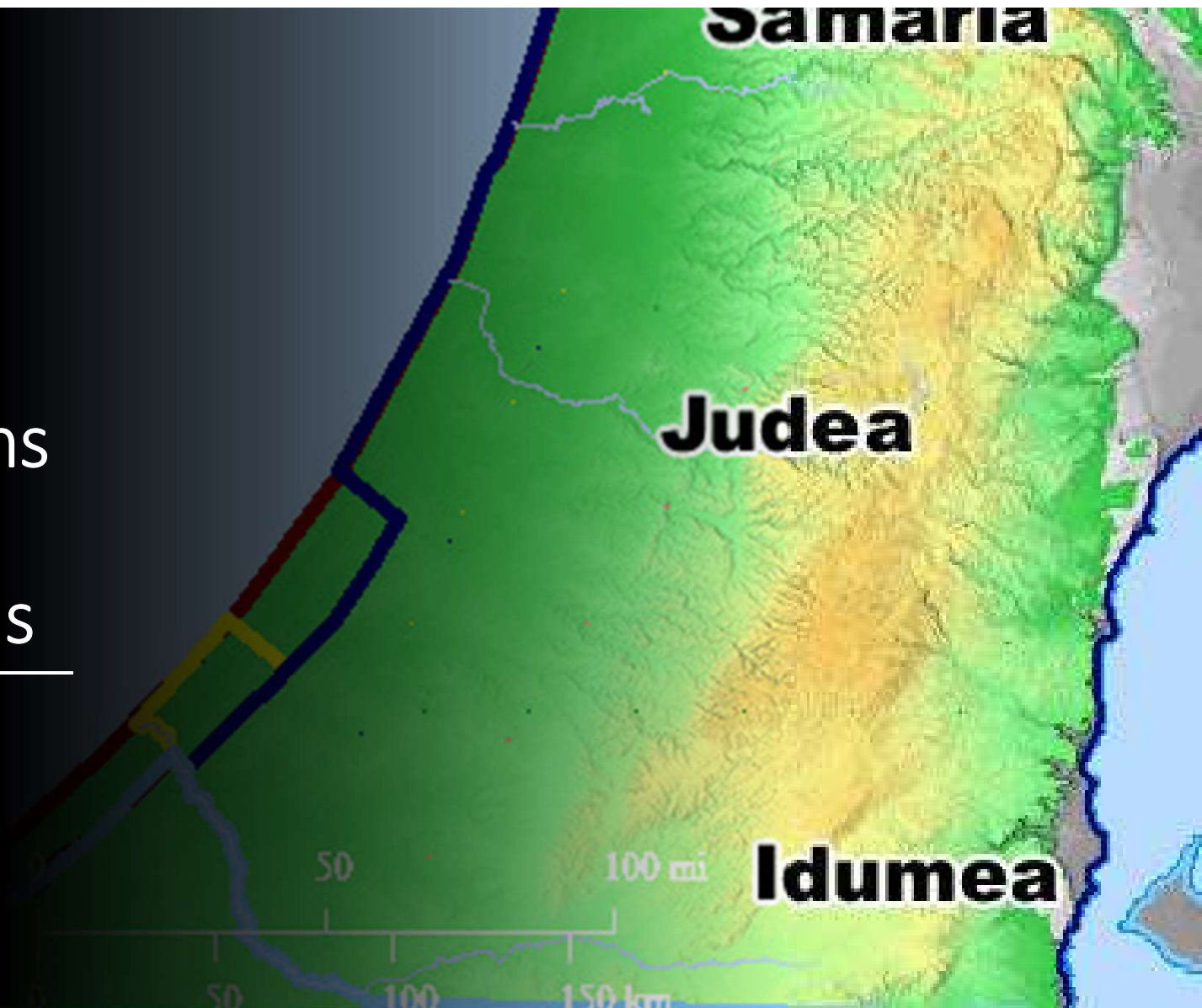



- The family of Esau and later tribe, initially established a kingdom just south of Judea called Edom



Later those people migrated to the territory within Judea (Mount Hebron) during the Persian occupation

By the Roman period they are inter-mingled with the Judeans and are known as the Idumeans





I close with the reminder that

Testament are all
Idumeans/Edomites.
