



This is the fourth installment on my series about the children of Abraham




In previous weeks we have discussed the children of **Abraham via his** descendents of Lot, his adopted son and nephew, who would have been Ammnon and Moab.




In the next lesson we examined the children of Ishmael, the first-born son to Abraham, who included 12 sons and two daughters



**Today we turn** to the second born son of Abraham which would have been Isaac who was the son of Sarah









Before getting to the children let's remember that the wife of Isaac is Rebekah who was the daughter of Nahor and Milchor.







In this particular lesson, we are focusing upon the descendants of Esau who would have been the great grandchildren of Abraham




Esau is the father of the "Edomites", which is confirmed in the Hebrew literature that is known to us as the Tanakh.
