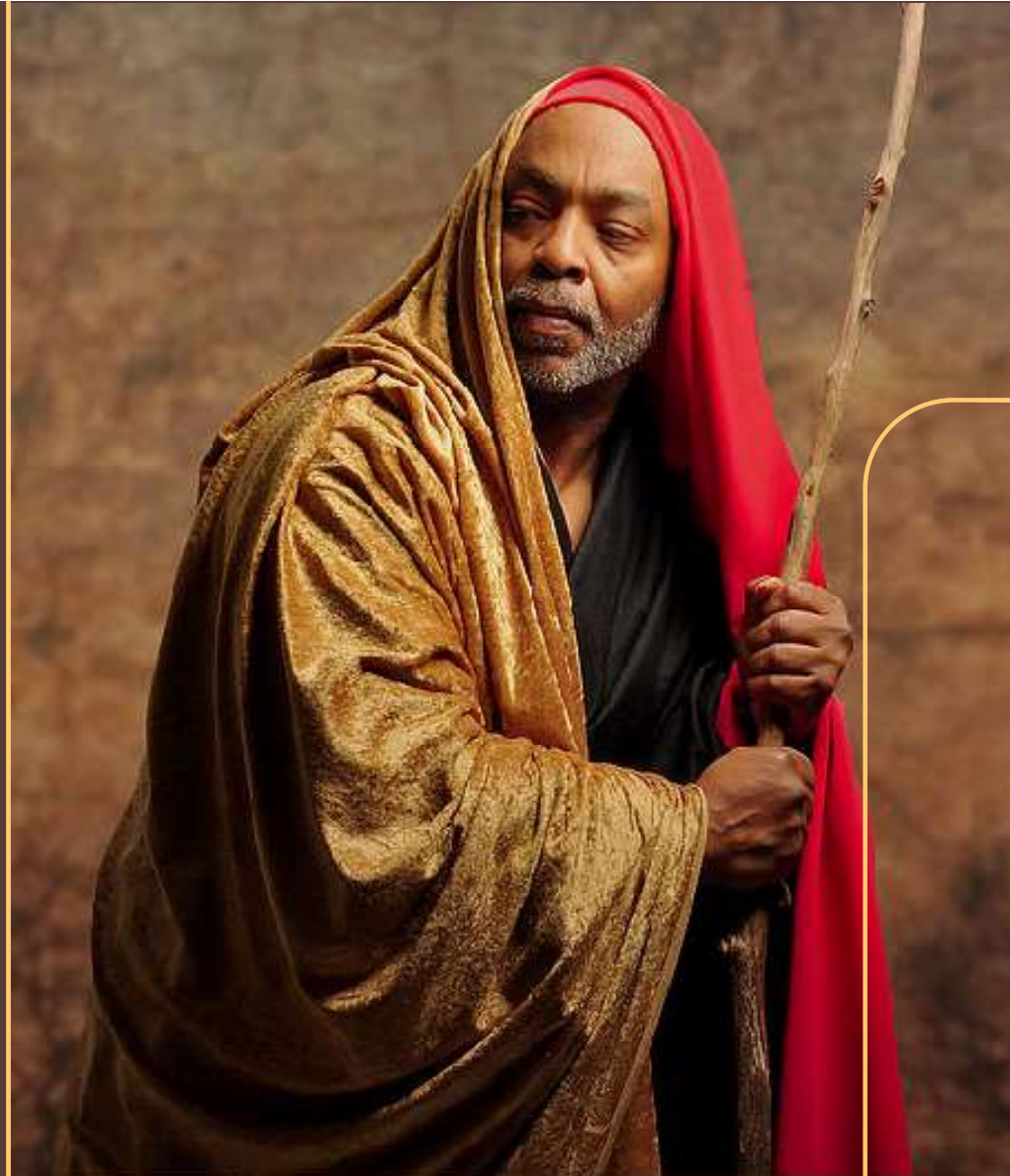


# Last week...

Part of that sermon series was God's promise to Abraham that he was going to make him the father of many nations



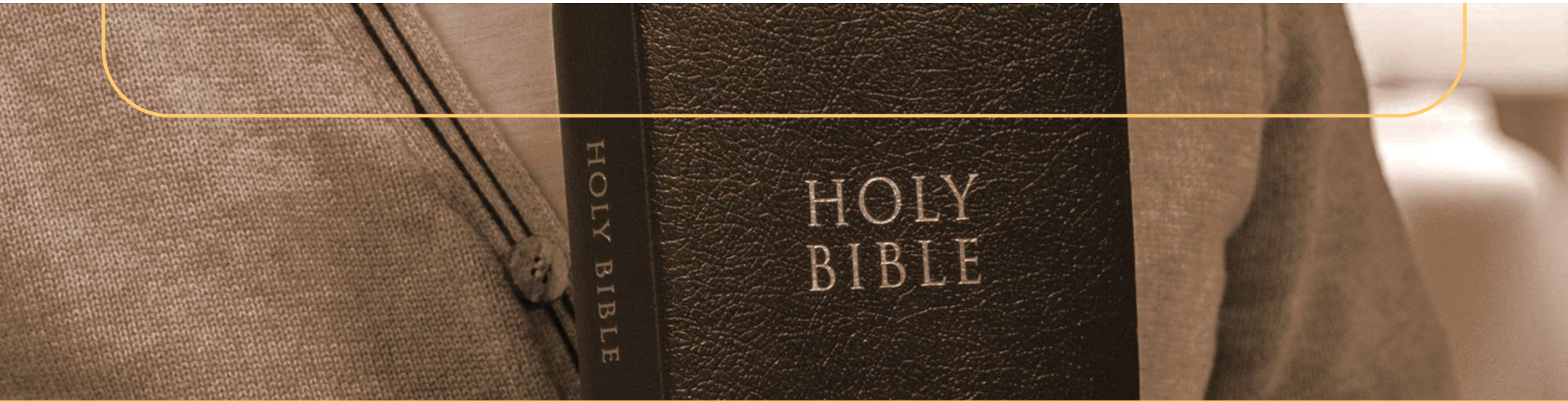
Of course, this promise was made to Abraham when he was well advanced in years and at a time when he had no current children of his own

the series




The branches to Abraham's tree included  
Lot, Ishmael, Isaac and the children of  
Keturah





This week we begin with  
the children of Lot






While Lot was not a biological son of Abraham I count him in this study because he was literally raised by Abraham after the death of Lot's father

According to Genesis ?? we are told that Terah, the brother of Abraham, dies early in the story and his son Lot was taken in by Abraham





It is this Lot, who is also the brother of Milchah who we will see later in the Abraham story, that joins Abraham in his journey to Canaan and later Egypt

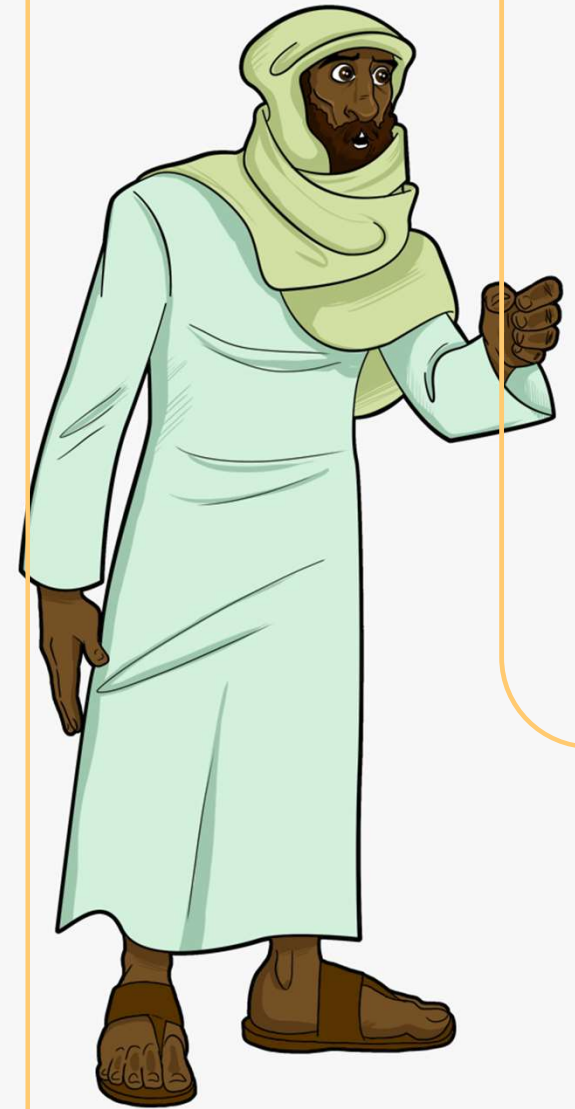

**The daughters of Lot fearing that they would have no children sleep with their father and become pregnant by Lot**



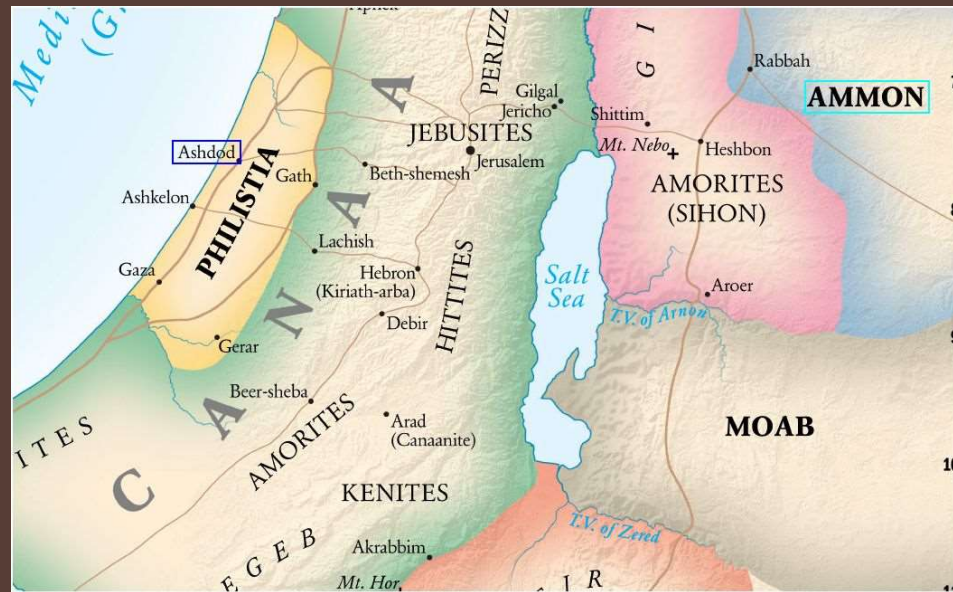


The children
