
The Story of Samson Part 3 (The House of the Harlot) Sermon Review





...we continue the story of Samson as found in the closing pages of chapters 15 and 16 in the Book of Judges


Again by now we have seen Samson born and raised as a Nazarite not to be confused with a Nazarene



Previously, Samson has found a wife in Tinmath that was pressured to find out the answer to his puzzle by her people the Philistines







Seemingly outmaneuvered, Samson kills 30 **Philistines and takes** their clothes to pay off his debt to the Philistines

When he returns to retrieve his wife he discovers that she had been given to his best man by her father







The absence of Samson is explained by according to Hebrew culture the first 6 months of a Hebrew marriage must be sent building a home for the new bride When the Philistines learn that their fields have been burned they retaliate by burning the wife of Samson along with her father






The same people who put her up to getting the answer to Samson's riddle are the same people who eventually takes her life along with that of her father






Samson enraged slays many of the Philistines and takes refuge in a cave near the tribe of Judah



Isn't it interesting that the Philistines use the people of Judah against the man that God had sent to deliver them (Warnock vs Walker)



Chapter 16 opens with a short encounter that Samson has for a prostitute of the Philistines




Before we pass moral judgement on the behaviour of Samson let us remember that it was all apart of God's plan to deliver Israel from the hands of the Philistines






The episode ends with Samson escaping again under the power of the spirit of God coming upon him
