



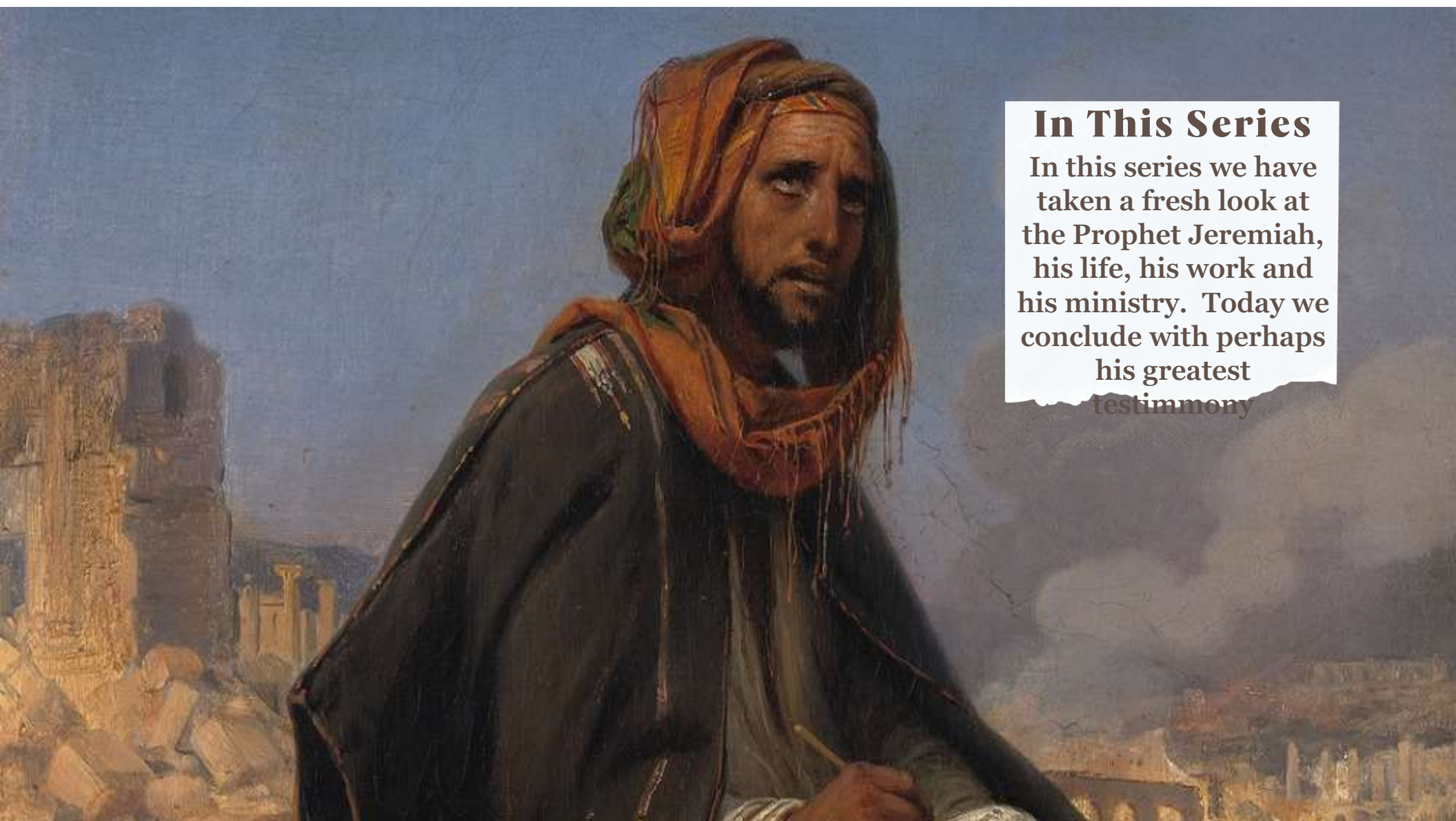

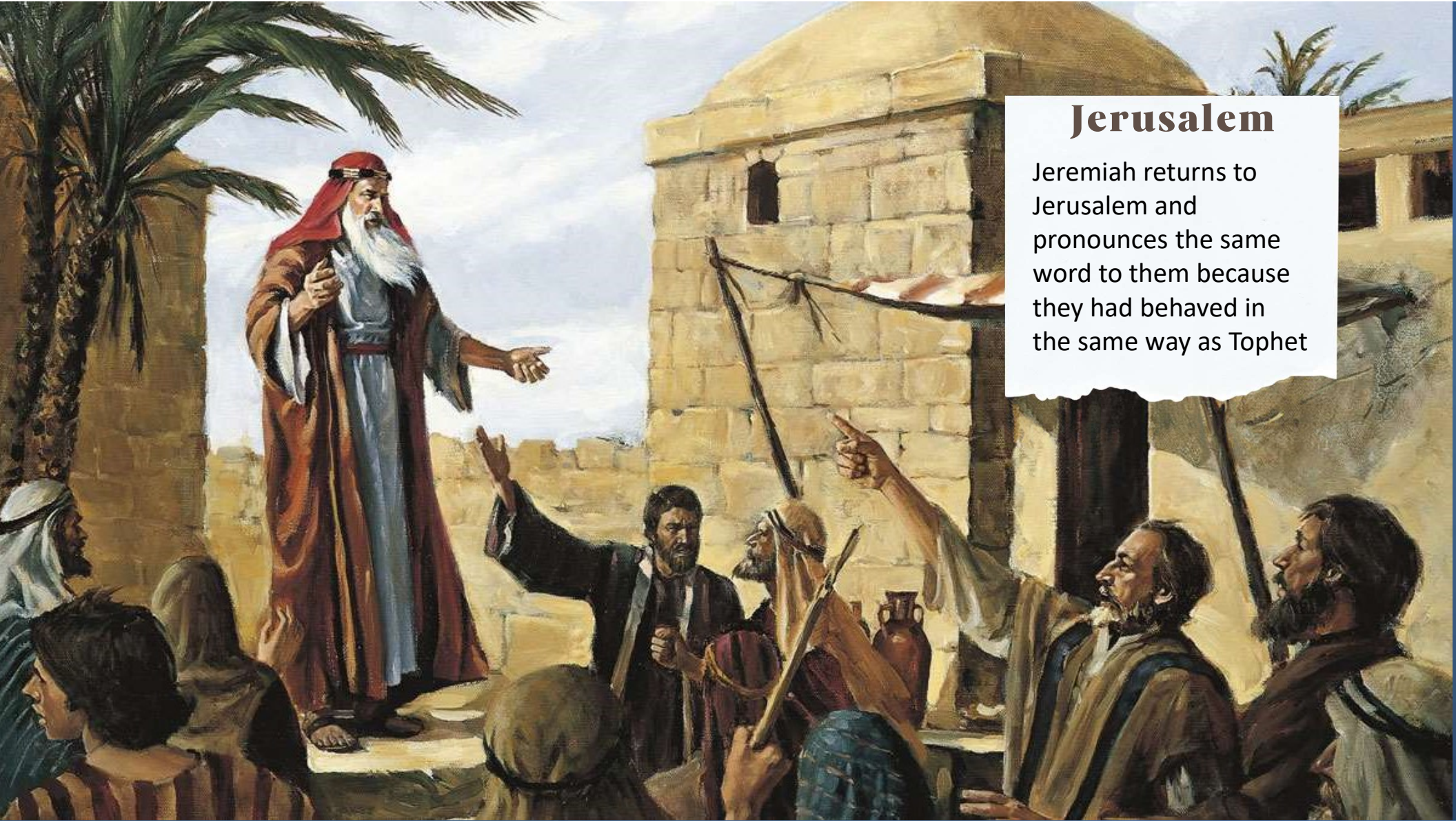
But his word was **in** mine heart as a burning **fire shut up in my bones**, and I was weary with forbearing, and I could not stay.

## Jerusalem

Jeremiah returns to Jerusalem and pronounces the same word to them because they had behaved in the same way as Tophet





## **Pashur**

When the head priest, Pashur, hears of Jeremiah's prophecy against Jerusalem he beats him and places Jeremiah in stocks next to the temple



## **The Next Day**


The following day when he is released, he calls Pashur a terror and resumes his prophecy against his house and the city of Jerusalem





## **Tries to be Quiet**

Knowing that his words mean trouble he tries to remain quiet and not prophesy in the name of the Lord. However, he describes it as fire shut up in his bones
