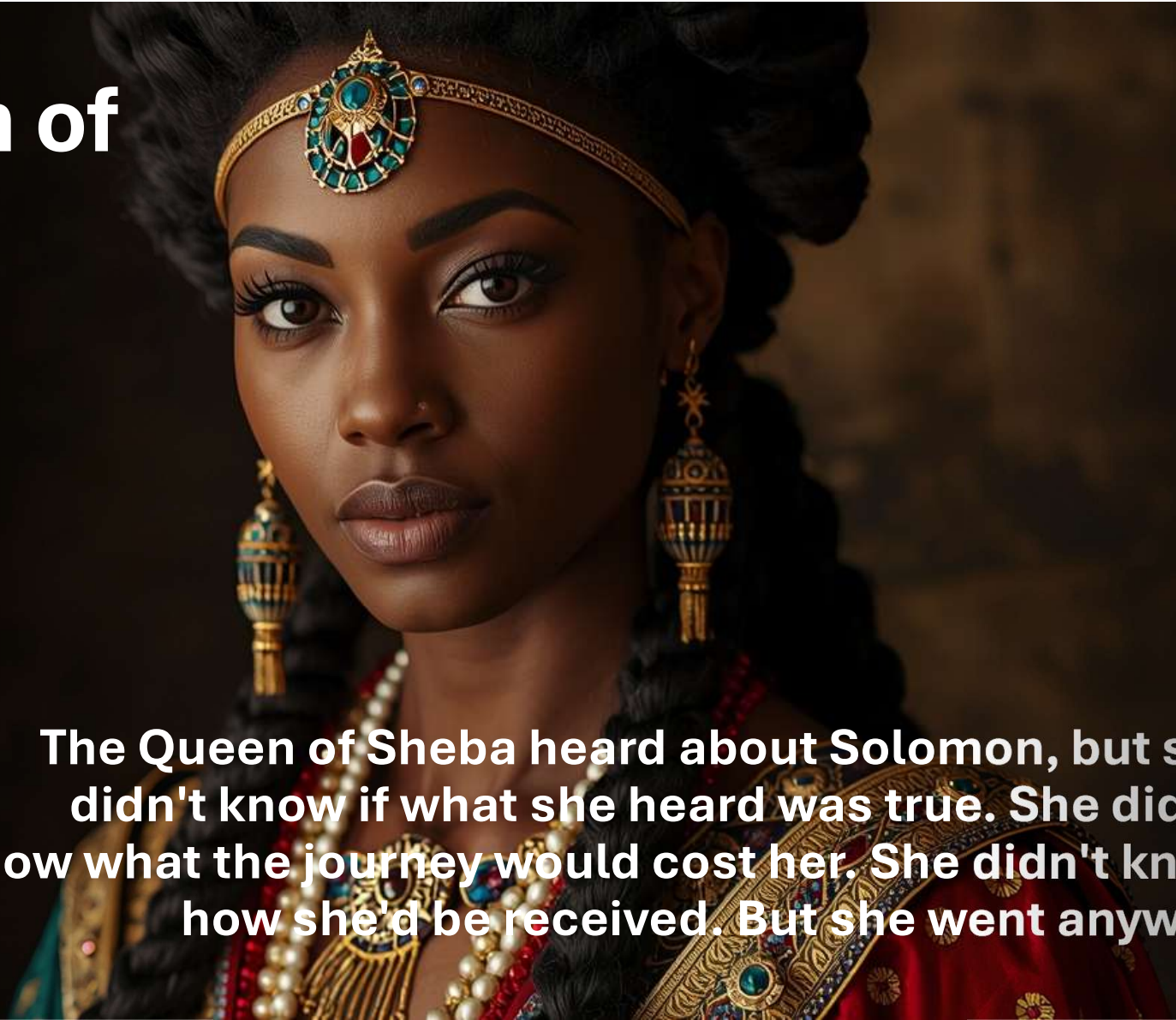

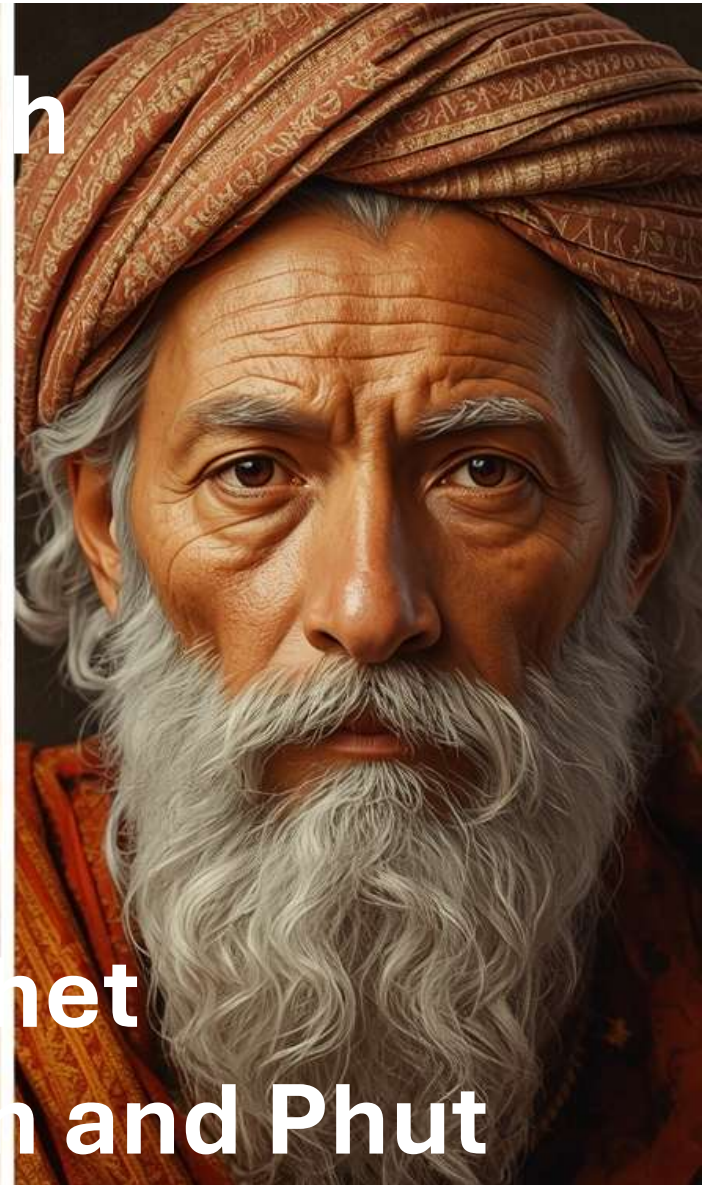
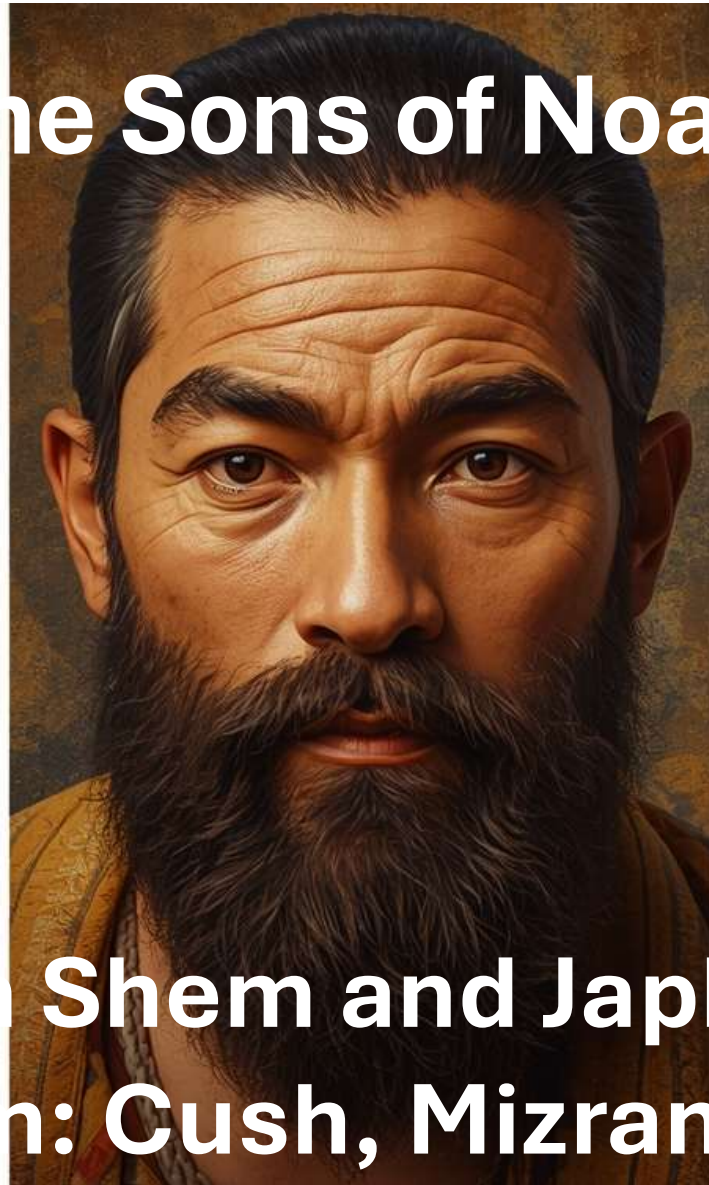
# The Queen of Sheba
