Romans Chapter 8

- V1: There is now no condemnation for those in Christ Jesus**
- V2: The law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made us free from the law of sin/death**
- V6: To be carnally minded is death – but to be spiritually minded is life and peace**
- V8: Those who are in the flesh cannot please GOD**
- V15: We have received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out Abba Father**
- V17: As His children, we are joint heirs with Christ**
- V26: The Spirit helps us in our weakness – making intercession on our behalf**
- V28: All things work together for good to those who love GOD**
- V30: If GOD is for us who can be against**
- V38-39: Nothing shall be able to separate us from the love of GOD which is in Christ Jesus our Lord**

- a defeater, victor, winner, champion


– for it is someone who dominates, defeats or overpowers.




