
Springs Creative invested in the company's first domestic digital textile printing resources. The result was dramatically increased speed to market with unparalleled color and detail print quality advancements.

Our digital printing facility is equipped with the very latest textile printing technology, providing significant advantages for our customers. We offer 3 printing methods: dye sublimation, pigment, and latex.

We also offer product development, color matching, and in-house artwork editing/ creation.

Our in-house design team, in partnership with the Baxter Mill Archive, identifies designs based on specific targeted lifestyles, trends and seasons. Services include CAD design, art customization, product development, trend and marketing services, digital printing, and color matching.

CREATIVE SERVICES

The process starts by discussing the final product, from substrate selection and choosing the best digital print method for the project, to finding the perfect archive for inspiration. The team then scans in the archive, or creates the original art, to meet digital print specifications.


Once the art is finalized, the file is then ready to print.



PERFORMANCE FABRICS

In an effort to manufacture the best digitally printed textiles in the industry and minimize our impact on the environment, we launched Springshield 2.0, our PFAs-free soil and stain performance outdoor finish.

When combined with latex printing, our substrates reach a lightfastness of over 1,000 hours.





TESTING LAB

Springs Digital operates a full featured testing lab in Fort Lawn, SC. Our facility conducts all the needed testing to provide COAs (Certificates of Analysis). We measure strength, elongation, shrinkage, thickness, air permeability, weight, abrasion, and thread count. Our lab also tests to reach various fire retardancy standards, colorfastness, accelerated laundering, and other common textile standards.


We pride ourselves on quick turnaround time and offer testing services to outside parties.

year to have one-on-one contact with team members, visit with strategic suppliers, and follow up on orders.

We are actively working with factories in the following countries: China, India, Pakistan, Turkey, South Korea, Thailand, Taiwan, and the United States. All our factories are audited for social compliance by third party auditing companies.
