

CLIENT DISCLOSURE & CONSENT

Dear Client:

Federal law requires us to obtain your consent before we use or disclose your tax return information for purposes other than preparing your return. We are well aware of the rules and restrictions involving the use and/or disclosure of your return information, and we take our obligations extremely seriously.

The Tax Code includes safeguards regarding the transfer and use of your personal tax return information. The rules affirm that you control your tax return information, not us or the IRS. The rules ensure that you know who your tax return information may be shared with, with and without your consent, and when it may be shared with and without your consent.

These rules give you even greater control over the use of your tax return information. Unless the law allows us otherwise (in very limited circumstances), we cannot disclose, without your signed permission, your tax return information to third parties for purposes other than for the purposes of preparing your tax return.
