

## **Who**

- Q-RILE.org: Quincy for Registration, Inspection, and Licensing Enforcement

## **What**

- Ordinance / Referendum: Rental Registration, Inspection, and Licensing ordinance to effect enforcement of existing city housing code

## **When**

- Now: Sign petition
- April 1, 2025 consolidated election: Vote YES on the referendum

## **Where**

- City of Quincy

## **Why**

- Quincy has a rental housing shortage
- Many rental units are in bad repair - some unsafe to live in - and not up to city housing code
- Landlords are allowed to rent those units
- Quincy does not have a rental inspection program to enforce existing city housing code
- Currently it is the tenants' responsibility to report code violations
- Tenants may not know what constitutes a violation
- Tenants may fear retaliation and eviction for reporting a code violation

## **How**

- Q-RILE was formed to change this unfair situation
- We ask voters to sign our petition in support of the referendum so that it can be added to the April 1, 2025 ballot
- Signing the petition, and voting YES on the April 1, 2025 ballot, will put the ordinance before the city council for a vote
- We ask voters to ask their alderperson to vote to pass and enact the ordinance
