Skijoring Rules

Canterbury Park, Shakopee MN February 21st and 22nd, 2025 Check in 8:00 AM to 9:45 AM on the 21st and 9.30 to 11:00 on the 22nd. If you entered both days you only have to check in on the 21st. Mandatory contestant meeting at 11:00 AM on the 21st.

- 1. Timed event: Timer starts when the skier crosses the start line and timer stops when skier crosses the finish line.
- 2. Rope: 35 feet (will be provided) The skier does not have to have the rope in their hand when they cross the finish line.
- 3. Penalties: Rings- 2 second addition for every ring missed. Gates- 2 second addition for every gate missed. Jumps-5 second addition for every jump missed.
- 4. You may enter for Saturday or Sunday or both. Only the teams that enter for both days will be eligible for the buckles and prizes. We will pay out prize money for each day. The payouts will be on Sunday. You may only enter once per class. We will bring back the top 6 in each class except the youth each day.
- 5. Freestyle: Two runs. It is a judged event.
- 6. Novice entries: Have not won money in a skijoring event at Canterbury
- 7. Youth entries: 17 and under. Rider and skier must be 17 or under the day of the event.
- 8. Western attire: Riders should be in western attire- skiers can wear whatever they want. Chaps are optional but encouraged. Helmets are OK.
- 9. Entry fees: Youth \$50/rider \$50/skier. Novice \$70/rider \$70/skier. Snowboarder \$70/rider \$70/skier. Open \$100/rider \$100.00/skier. There are no refunds. Any changes must be made by February 14th 2025.
- 10. Added money: \$500.00 will be added to the Novice event and \$1000.00 will be added to the Open event. Buckles to the fastest time of the weekend. \$200.00 will be added to the Youth and \$500.00 will be added to the Snow board division. \$1000 to the freestyle.
- 11. Payout: Top six in each event.
- 12. Buckles will be awarded to the average winners of the weekend.
