

## Skijoring rules

### Canterbury Park, Shakopee MN February 12th, 2022, 1:00 PM

1. **Timed event:** Timer starts when the skier crosses the line and timer stops when skier crosses the finish line.
2. **Penalties:** Rings- 2 second addition for every ring missed. Gates- 2 second addition for every gate missed. Jumps-5 second addition for every jump missed.
3. **First round:** All teams will compete one time
4. **Final round:** Top four in the novice and snowboard and the top 6 in the open class will advance to the finals.
5. **Freestyle:** Three runs. It is a judged event.
6. **Western attire:** Riders should be in western attire including cowboy hat. Chaps are optional but encouraged. Helmets are OK.
7. **Entry fees:** \$50.00 per rider and \$50.00 per skier. Open \$60.00
8. **Added money:** \$300.00 will be added to the Novice event and \$500.00 will be added to the Open event. Buckles to the event winners. \$200.00 will be added to the Youth and \$300.00 will be added to the Snow board division. \$300 to the freestyle.
9. **Entries:** Each team may enter one time only. Each person may enter more than once.
10. **Novice entries:** Have not won money in a skijoring event at Canterbury
11. **Youth entries:** 17 and under.
12. **Payout:** Top four in each event.
13. **Rope:** 35 feet 7/8 thick (will be provided).
14. **The skier does not have to have the rope in their hand when they cross the finish line.**
