The horsemanship and interview portion will take place at the Carver County Fairgrounds on May 31st at 10:00 am. We will start with horsemanship, each queen contestant must bring their own horse to ride.

We encourage you to be as thorough as possible with your answers on this application. All applications are subject to approval by the EEMN Queen committee and the application deadline to be received is May 21st, 2025. EEMN reserves the right to refuse any contestant application. If a contestant is refused entry in the contest, there will be no appeal process.

Include with your application:

- This entry form, typed or black ink only (use additional paper/space as needed)
- Two professional pictures of yourself, one is to be a headshot in full western apparel, the other a full body picture. No personal crown or sash is allowed.
- Signed participant contract and waiver.

1. I will attend all required activities and events as scheduled and directed (Schedule and activities will be available at a later date).
2. I will maintain a desirable attitude, professional conduct, be honest and upfront.
3. I will meet all eligibility requirements.
4. I will not act, appear, or be under the influence of alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs at any time while representing EEMN as queen.

5. I will not attempt to influence or affect the outcome of the contest at the expense of a fellow contestant, a contestant's property or horse, or any other behavior or conduct deemed unacceptable by the Coordinator and/or Judges.
6. I agree for pictures to be released to newspapers as well as other publications for publicity, social media, et al., of EEMN.
7. I understand that riding and horsemanship skills are key to the promotion of the sport of rodeo and skjoring. Therefore, I will strive to continually improve my riding and horsemanship skills so that I can better promote the sport and EEMN productions.

1. As a EEMN Queen contestant, I shall represent the company and rodeo in a positive, professional and honorable manner.
2. I will adhere to and demonstrate high moral, ethical and professional character.
3. I will represent excellent sportsmanship and humane treatment of animals in all competitive and recreational activities.
4. I will act, dress, and speak properly at any time while in public, including appearing in full western attire with hat, crown and sash when appropriate.
5. I will be available to all reasonable requests and opportunities to appear in public on behalf of Extreme Events MN.
6. I will allow my name and likeness to be used at no obligation in the promotion of EEMN.

If I become Miss Extreme Events MN Queen I agree to:

Avail myself of all opportunities to appear as Miss EEMN to the public and to be prepared for photographs and interview opportunities at all time to promote EEMN and the sport of rodeo.

I agree that throughout my reign as Miss EEMN Queen, I shall observe a high standard of moral and ethical behavior in public and online.

I agree that my behavior and all posts reflecting myself will be befitting my title and set a good example to the public, future competitors, EEMN and the sport of rodeo. This is including but not limited to Facebook, Instagram, X, Snapchat, YouTube, and TikTok. Personal websites & blogs. As well as content posted by others in which the likeness of Miss Extreme Events MN is used or associated.

I understand that content found online or in public can be subject to disciplinary action up to and when necessary, including the removal of her title of Miss EEMN.

I will not at any time during the contest or as reigning queen drink alcoholic beverages, smoke, or use foul language in public.

Violation of this may result in the removal of the title of Miss EEMN.

I agree to provide my own horse and transportation to all events as necessary, including but not limited to: Waconia, Skijoring and Shakopee Rodeo.

I agree to participate at all the required 2026 EEMN events and performances.

I agree to attend and participate in the 2025/26 EEMN Queen contest.

I agree to abide by all rules and regulations of the PRCA and/or other organizations while participating in any rodeo or other events, including but not limited to animal welfare rules & regulations.

By entering into this contest and assuming the title of Miss EEMN I agree that I have read and understand the Rules and Regulations and will abide by these rules during the entire Miss EEMN Queen Pageant and during my reign as Miss EEMN, should I earn the title. Failure of the 2026 EEMN to attend the above could result in the immediate disqualification as 2026 EEMN and relinquishment of the crown, chaps, et al., as well as title as 2026 EEMN.

EEMN Queen Pageant Schedule

Friday, May 30th 6:00 pm - Queen contestants will meet at the DiYDCo trailer for their tickets into the rodeo and introductions. Not mandatory, but it is encouraged that Queen contestants attend the first performance as part of the interview will include the production.

9:30 pm – End of Rodeo: Queen contestants will meet at DiYDCo trailer to confirm plans for the morning.

Saturday, May 31st 10:00 am: Horsemanship immediately followed by interviews.

Judges will discuss at the conclusion of interviews while the contestants put up and tend to their horses.

The top three contestants will then be chosen and brought to the Canterbury Park Rodeo in Shakopee, MN July 18th-20th to act as ambassadors for the weekend and evaluated on horsemanship, social skills, representation, etc. On July 20th the 2026 Extreme Events MN Queen will be chosen during the 1:00 pm performance. The first big event for the 2026 EEMN Queen is skijoring at Canterbury Park February 28th 2026.
