Before they flew off to establish personal contact with them and ultimately to have their lives end savagely on sandbar, the pilot Nate was saying good bye to his wife and children when his oldest son Steve asked him, "If they come after you, will you defend yourself and shoot them?" His dad replies, "They're not ready for heaven, we are." The story is very emotional and shows the power of forgiveness and that that even after having their husbands brutally murdered, the wives with their children return to the tribe, live with them and ultimately share the plan of salvation with them and they become born again.

I was reminded that today in our society, we have gangs and rival gangs, mafia, terrorists; and making it more personal we can be living in the carnal things of the flesh as Galatians 5:15-26 says, with those around us in our personal worlds. It's the same Jesus we preach about today as these missionaries did with the Waodani. Jesus is the same yesterday, today and forever. Let's be bold in sharing our faith with those in our worlds who need the love and forgiveness of Jesus, just as this Stone Age tribe did in the jungles of Ecuador.
