<u>Killing Jesus</u> was released on March 29, 2015. An ambitious movie by the National Geographic Channel, this movie was filmed solely in Morocco. It was taken from the book entitled the same by Bill O'Reilly and Martin Dugard and was produced by Ridley Scott.

It's very raw, focusing on the humanity of Jesus and not as much on His divinity which some may criticize. Some scenes may seem abrasive and almost unreal or too suggestive as the scene with Antipas and his step-daughter Salome and the beheading of John the Baptist.
