

Overview of Prayer Meeting June 15th, 2025

Here at Salvation Studio House, we dedicate at least one service per month for a prayer meeting. As we always do, we start with a time of worship and end with taking the Lord's Supper. We always remember in prayer that Jesus has given us authority in His name, that we can take and possess the promises that He has given us, and to also take authority over the plans and attacks of the devil, according to **Luke 10:19**; *"Behold! I have given you authority and power to trample upon serpents and scorpions, and [physical and mental strength and ability] over all the power that the enemy [possesses]; and nothing shall in any way harm you."* and **Mark 16:17-18**; *"17 And these attesting signs will accompany those who believe: in My name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new languages; 18 They will pick up serpents; and [even] if they drink anything deadly, it will not hurt them; they will lay their hands on the sick, and they will get well."*

We always talk about praying in tongues, our heavenly spiritual language, and how important it is according to **Romans 8:26**; *"So too the [Holy] Spirit comes to our aid and bears us up in our weakness; for we do not know what prayer to offer nor how to offer it worthily as we ought, but the Spirit Himself goes to meet our supplication and pleads in our behalf with unspeakable yearnings and groanings too deep for utterance."* Holy Spirit knows all and when we pray in tongues, He intercedes on our behalf praying the perfect will of God. As we pray in tongues, the Holy Spirit instructs us who and what to pray for.

We prayed over the G7 meeting in Kananaskis, Alberta, that was happening from June 15-17, 2025. This place is about 2.5 hours from where we live. These global leaders of the 7 richest countries really think they have the wisdom and knowledge to know how to 'lead' the world, yet they're not surrendered to the Lordship of Jesus Christ. **Psalms 2:1-6** says that the Lord sits in the heavens and laughs at them, *"1 Why do the nations assemble with commotion [uproar and confusion of voices], and why do the people imagine (meditate upon and devise) an empty scheme? 2 The kings of the earth take their places; the rulers take counsel together against the Lord and His Anointed One (the Messiah, the Christ). They say, 3 Let us break Their bands [of restraint] asunder and cast Their cords [of control] from us. 4 He Who sits in the heavens laughs; the Lord has them in derision [and in supreme contempt He mocks them]. 5 He speaks to them in His deep anger and troubles (terrifies and confounds) them in His displeasure and fury, saying, 6 Yet have I anointed (installed and placed) My King [firmly] on My holy hill of Zion."*

The only true wisdom and knowledge comes from the Most High God, who is Lord God over all. We interceded that they would come to be born again of the Spirit of God and that their scheming and plotting against the Lord would be revealed. The Lord's will will be done regardless of the schemes of man and the global agendas that they are trying to move forward.

The Bible says that we're to forgive those who are at enmity with us according to **Ephesians 4:32**; *"And become useful and helpful and kind to one another, tenderhearted (compassionate, understanding, loving-hearted), forgiving one another [readily and freely], as God in Christ forgave you."* and **Mark 11:25**; *"And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him and [a]let it drop (leave it, let it go), in order that your Father Who is in heaven may also forgive you your [own] failings and shortcomings and let them drop."* So we forgive our leaders who do not have our best interest in mind. We also prayed against the riots that have been happening in the USA over the past weeks. The Bible says that lawlessness will abound in the last days, but Jesus says we're still to pray and take authority over the devils schemes that are driving lawlessness.

We read **Psalm 7** where David is praying for deliverance from his enemies which says the following;
*“O Lord my God, in You I put my trust; Save me from all those who persecute me; And deliver me,
2 Lest they tear me like a lion, Rending me in pieces, while there is none to deliver.*

*3 O Lord my God, if I have doe this: If there is iniquity in my hands,
4 If I have repaid evil to him who was at peace with me, Or have plundered my enemy without cause,
5 Let the enemy pursue me and overtake me; Yes, let him trample my life to the earth, And lay my honor
in the dust. Selah*

*6 Arise, O Lord, in Your anger; Lift Yourself up because of the rage of my enemies; Rise up [b]for
me to the judgment You have commanded!*

7 So the congregation of the peoples shall surround You; For their sakes, therefore, return on high.

*8 The Lord shall judge the peoples; Judge me, O Lord, according to my righteousness, And according
to my integrity within me.*

*9 Oh, let the wickedness of the wicked come to an end, But establish the just; For the righteous God
tests the hearts and [c]minds.*

10 [d]My defense is of God, Who saves the upright in heart.

11 God is a just judge, And God is angry with the wicked every day.

12 If he does not turn back, He will sharpen His sword; He bends His bow and makes it ready.

13 He also prepares for Himself instruments of death; He makes His arrows into fiery shafts.

14 Behold, the wicked brings forth iniquity; Yes, he conceives trouble and brings forth falsehood.

15 He made a pit and dug it out, And has fallen into the ditch which he made.

*16 His trouble shall return upon his own head, And his violent dealing shall come down on [e]his own
crown.*

*17 I will praise the Lord according to His righteousness, And will sing praise to the name of
the Lord Most High.*

What a powerful scripture to pray!

We read this scripture verse from **Matthew 26:26-30** when we took communion. It says; *“26 And as
they were eating, Jesus took bread, [a]blessed and broke it, and gave it to the disciples and
said, “Take, eat; this is My body.” 27 Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them,
saying, “Drink from it, all of you. 28 For this is My blood of the [b]new covenant, which is shed for
many for the [c]remission of sins. 29 But I say to you, I will not drink of this fruit of the vine from now
on until that day when I drink it new with you in My Father’s kingdom.” 30 And when they had sung a
hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives.”*
