

Overview of Prayer Service, October 26th, 2025

James 5:16 says; *“Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.”*

If you are blood bought and blood washed by the blood of Jesus Christ, you’ve been made righteous to our Heavenly Father. **2 Corinthians 5:21** says; *“For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that might become the righteousness of God in Him.”*

Therefore, because we are righteous, and we wear the breastplate of righteousness, our prayers avail much. The devil continually lies to Christians that the Lord doesn’t hear them, but He does if we walk humbly before Him.

These are a few scriptures that we read during our time of prayer;

Hebrews 4:16 says this; *“Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.”*

2 Chronicles 7:14 says; *“if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.”*

2 Thessalonians 5:16-18 says; *“16 Rejoice always, 17 pray without ceasing, 18 in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.”*

The Bible says that we *“walk by faith and not by sight”* in **2 Corinthians 5:7**, which also applies to praying. There are times when maybe your emotions or feelings are not into prayer, but we don’t allow that to dictate our prayers.

We spent a good bit of time praying for our political leaders, both provincially and federally. There is a lot of talk in Alberta, our province, about separation from Canada and becoming an independent country or state, so we prayed for the Lord’s will to be done regarding that. We’ve also seen for a few years now, especially after the lock-downs due to the ‘virus’, that men who have a call of God on them for either the five-fold ministry or otherwise, are being lured into politics and becoming double-minded, trying to do both, thinking that their political influence will be greater than the call on their lives. We believe that God desires and will raise up the right men and women to lead righteously in our nation but there are those who God specifically calls to ministry, who have a call and election to fulfill. The temptation for such is media attention, rubbing shoulders with famous politicians and people, and maybe even financial benefits. When God calls a man, it’s to either one or the other, be a preacher or be a politician, not both.

The false teaching of the New Apostolic Reformation (NAR) has been sweeping Charismatic/Pentecostal churches for a number of decades now, which believes that Christians have to take over seven mountains of influence on earth to be able to usher in the Kingdom of God. Those areas of influence include religion, family, education, government, media, business and the arts. We will not expound on all of this as you can search it out on your own time, but what it’s done is diverted many Christians away from ministry that God has called them to, into the secular. It’s very deceptive and many Christians are mixing Christianity with politics. There is a distinction. **James 1:8** says; *“he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.”* Many who follow this path, end up being double-

mindful and start wavering as the world throws so many diversions across their path, and they forget the call on their lives.

We prayed again for the trade/tariff dispute between the USA and Canada. This has been going on for months now, but we continue to pray for the Lord's will to be done. We have leaders who are full of pride and arrogance, looking to push their own agenda's, who are full of selfish ambition and are at loggerheads with each other. We know the demonic agenda is to rob, kill and destroy and we see this at work as prices go up at the food store, people loosing their jobs etc. We prayed for God's mercy over Canada as we see leaders pushing their godless agenda's on the nation. Even as Daniel prayed and repented for the sins of his nation in Daniel 9:1-19, so we prayed and repented of the sins of our nation, that God would forgive and heal from following after the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, which according to **1 John 2:16**, is not of the Father but of the world. Ultimately, our dependency is not from one nation or another, but on Jesus alone.

Proverbs 21:1-2 says; *"The king's heart is in the hand of the Lord, like the rivers of water; He turns it wherever He wishes. Every way of a man is right in his own eyes, but the Lord weighs the hearts."* We prayed this scripture over the Prime Minister of Canada and the President of the USA.

Psalms 91:7-8 says; *"A thousand may fall at your side, and ten thousand and your right hand; but it shall not come near you. Only with your eyes shall you look, and see the reward of the wicked."* Regardless of the political decisions that are made, this is the word we stand on.

Daniel 2:21 says; *"And He changes the times and seasons; He removes kings and raises up kings..."* We sense that there will be a removal of key political leaders in Canada that God will do, and place in their positions men who are called to rule with the fear of God.

Galatians 6:7 says; *"Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap."* God sees all things, that which is not only done in public but in private and even the motive and intent of the heart and He will judge accordingly to leaders in Canada who have led corruptly and perversely. Those who have mocked and scorned God's authority and will, will be held accountable to Him for what they've done.

We also prayed for two people in Canada who have become household names and were part of the truckers freedom convoy during the lock-downs in 2022; Chris Barber and Tamara Lich. They've each been placed on house arrest for one year, so we prayed for God's will to be done and that somehow or someway there would be a change to the judges ruling on this.

We ended praying **Psalms 27** over us and it's a good scripture to pray over yourselves;

*1 The Lord is my light and my salvation; Whom shall I fear? The Lord is the strength of my life;
Of whom shall I be afraid?*

2 When the wicked came against me To eat[a] up my flesh, My enemies and foes, They stumbled and fell.

*3 Though an army may encamp against me, My heart shall not fear; Though war may rise against me,
In this I will be confident.*

*4 One thing I have desired of the Lord, That will I seek: That I may dwell in the house of the Lord
All the days of my life, To behold the [b]beauty of the Lord, And to inquire in His temple.*

*5 For in the time of trouble He shall hide me in His pavilion; In the secret place of His tabernacle
He shall hide me; He shall set me high upon a rock.*

6 And now my head shall be [c]lifted up above my enemies all around me; Therefore I will offer sacrifices of [d]joy in His tabernacle; I will sing, yes, I will sing praises to the Lord.

7 Hear, O Lord, when I cry with my voice! Have mercy also upon me, and answer me.

8 When You said, "Seek My face," My heart said to You, "Your face, Lord, I will seek."

9 Do not hide Your face from me; Do not turn Your servant away in anger; You have been my help; Do not leave me nor forsake me, O God of my salvation.

10 When my father and my mother forsake me, Then the Lord will take care of me.

11 Teach me Your way, O Lord, And lead me in a smooth path, because of my enemies.

12 Do not deliver me to the will of my adversaries; For false witnesses have risen against me, And such as breathe out violence.

13 I would have lost heart, unless I had believed That I would see the goodness of the Lord In the land of the living.

14 Wait[e] on the Lord; Be of good courage, And He shall strengthen your heart; Wait, I say, on the Lord!"

We ended our prayer service with communion as we do in every service. Don't loose heart saints of God. He is with you and will never leave you nor forsake you!
