

Overview of Prayer Meeting – August 24th, 2025

Matthew 18:19 says the following; *“Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven.”*

Matthew 6:10 says; *“Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.”*

Prayer is such an honour that the Lord has given us to have communion with Him, to see mountains and obstacles in our lives be removed and so much more. It’s also a point of contention with our adversary the devil, as he wants to keep us away from that communion and power. So we contend to pray not just for a few minutes each day but to live in a lifestyle of prayer, and as a church, that’s what we endeavour to do.

The Lord led us to pray for Spirit-filled Christians in our community who are not in church fellowship anywhere. We prayed for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon them as some have maybe lost hope, become discouraged or have just been distracted by the things of this world or have lost their first love of Christ. As we’ve said previously, there are tremendous demonic attacks against Spirit-filled believers, lying to them about the power of speaking in tongues, about the authority that they’re able to walk in and the devil will use anyone or anything to get them off track. We believe, according to what the Bible says, that all Christians are to be baptized in the Holy Spirit and speak in tongues. All of that to say that it doesn’t stop the enemies attacks on our lives.

BUT, we have power to overcome all the fiery darts of the devil and **Ephesians 6:14-18** shows us the armour of God that is available to us to overcome. It says; *“14 Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, 15 and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; 16 above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to **quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one**. 17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; 18 praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints.”*

Verse 18 encourages us how to pray for the saints, the Christians, and one powerful way is to pray in tongues, or in the Spirit for them because you’re praying the perfect will of God when you do. **1 John 4:4** says; *“You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.”*

Church, we must stand strong as we just read in Ephesians 6. We cannot become weary in well-doing. **2 Peter 1:2-4** says we’ve been given everything that we have need of to stand strong in Jesus; *“2 Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, 3 as **His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness**, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, 4 by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the [c]orruption that is in the world through lust.”*

We encourage you to have a lifestyle of prayer, pray in tongues (in the Spirit), and pray in the understanding. **1 Corinthians 14:15** says; *“What is the conclusion then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will also pray with the understanding. I will sing with the spirit, and I will also sing with the understanding.”*
