



Privacy Policy: Updated February 11, 2025

Alpine Legal Services (“ALS,” “we,” “us”) respects your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, and protect information you provide through our website and communications.

1. Information We Collect

We collect information you submit to us, such as your name, contact information (including phone number and email), and information about your legal issue. If you sign up for updates, we collect the information you provide through the website.

2. How We Use Information

We use your information to respond to you, evaluate whether ALS can assist, provide services or resources when appropriate, and communicate with you (including by phone, email, or text if you opt in).

3. Text Messages

If you opt in to receive text messages from ALS, we may send messages related to your inquiry, services, appointments, or updates. Message and data rates may apply. You can opt out at any time by replying **STOP**.

4. Sharing of Information

We do not sell your personal information. **No mobile information will be shared with third parties/affiliates for marketing/promotional purposes. All the above categories exclude text messaging originator opt-in data and consent; this information will not be shared with any third parties.** We may share information only with service providers that help us operate our website and communications, and only as necessary to provide services, or if required by law.

5. Security

Information submitted through our website may be encrypted and transmitted using industry-standard security measures (such as SSL).

6. No Attorney-Client Relationship

Submitting information through our website does not create an attorney-client relationship. Submission does not guarantee ALS can assist you. If we cannot assist, we will do our best to provide information or resources that may help.
