



# EAF Funding for Neurodiverse Employees

## Did you know?

The **Employment Assistance Fund** (EAF) gives up to **\$1,680/year** in support for employees with diagnosed ADHD, Autism & other qualifying conditions.

Here's what you need to know + how to get help applying.

## Who is eligible?

- Employees, job seekers, self-employed people with a formal diagnosis of a disability.
- Conditions can include ADHD, Autism Spectrum Disorder, and other neurodivergent or qualifying conditions.
- You may ask someone to apply as your nominee (company representative or support person) if needed.

## What the EAF Covers

- **ADHD Coaching** (practical workplace strategies, focus tools, and inclusion support)
- Workplace adjustments or modifications (lighting, equipment, software)
- Assistive technology or communication devices
- Other supports/services necessary to perform duties of work

## How to Apply / Key Steps

1. Check eligibility on JobAccess.
2. Fill out the EAF online application via JobAccess Secure.
3. Get approval (may include a free workplace assessment if needed)/
4. Once approved, acquire the items/services (like ADHD Coaching). JobAccess reimburses costs directly.
