I agree to the fullest extent allowed by law, to protect, indemnify, and hold FFGE, its agents, representatives, employees, volunteers, successors, and assigns, harmless from all claims or liability of every type (including court costs and legal fees) for any injury, death, or damage arising out of or relating to my services as a volunteer of FFGE, whether or not caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of FFGE, its agents, representatives, employees, volunteers, successors, and assigns. I further agree that I will indemnify and hold harmless all of the above individuals or entities from any loss, liability, damage, or costs which may be incurred as a result of any claim that may be made. Release of Liability. I agree and hereby acknowledge that I am aware of the risks associated with volunteering
	with FFGE. I agree to wear close-toed, non-slip shoes when I am volunteering. I hereby assume, accept, and acknowledge all responsibility for any dangers, accidents, risks, and hazards associated with said volunteer services provided by me to FFGE and its successors and assigns, and I hereby agree to indemnify and hold FFGE, its agents, representatives, employees, volunteers, successors, and assigns harmless from any injuries, claims, demands, causes of action, and damages, including attorney's fees, resulting from any accident, incident, or occurrence arising out of or relating to my volunteer services provided to FFGE and its successors and assigns, whether or not caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of FFGE, its agents, representatives, employees, volunteers, successors, and assigns.

I agree that if, as part of my volunteer efforts, I am required operate a motor vehicle on behalf of FFGE, I must have and do have a valid Illinois driver's license that has not been suspended, revoked or is otherwise invalid.
