Each device was walked and all trash and debris within device perimeters was removed. Woody vegetation throughout each device was controlled or hand pulled. The water level in BMP 1 is very low, likely due to a defective or leaking drain valve. The drain valve in BMP 1 does not function (wheel will not turn). Riprap in BMP 1 has lost position, recommend repairs. Beneficial vegetation in BMP 1 looks stressed, likely from being newly planted and the low water level. Overall BMP 1 is deficient, will send a deficiency report to our office. The drain valve in BMP 2 does not function. BMP 3 has areas lacking mulch, recommend re-mulching in the coming months. BMP 3 outlet has minor accumulated sediment, will continue to monitor. All other components were functioning properly. Please contact our office with any additional questions, concerns, or to schedule repairs.
