Special Religious Education (SRE) Teacher

Role Description

Teach SRE in local public schools

Responsibilities

- Obtain a Pastor Endorsement Form
- Prepare SRE lessons using an approved curriculum e.g. GodSpace
- Adhere to the school's requirements and requests, such as:
 - use Service NSW app etc to check-in and out
 - wear name badge/Green Card
- Ongoing professional development, lesson reflection and observation
- Pray for SRE students
- Help other school SRE Teachers if required
- Be the SRE Coordinator if you are the only SRE teacher

Prerequisites and/or skills required

- Church member, and/or agree with the "Responsibilities of Membership" listed in the Constitution (5.c.)
- Compliance with the Procedure for Staff and Volunteers (Category 2 a - Volunteers in leadership roles, engaged in child-related work and/or engaged in work with vulnerable adults)
- Be authorised to teach SRE by the Baptist Union of NSW (Approved Provider)
