Service Prayer

Role Description

To lead a time of prayer during the Sunday morning worship service, focusing and guiding the congregation in a meaningful way

Responsibilities

- When preparing, spend time in personal prayer, allowing the Holy Spirit to guide your thoughts and words. Have your prayer, or a prayer outline, written down.
- Prepare prayer points prior to the service, taking into consideration:
 - Significant local and global current events
 - The monthly mission focus as designated by the Missions Team
 - KKBC
 - Church members and attendees (ensuring confidentiality is always maintained)
 - Our local community and people, Kurri Kurri and surrounds
- Be sensitive to, and aware of, topics which may cause discomfort or be triggering for some
- Be mindful of the time dedicated to praying (blending into the whole service)
- Remember the distinction between prayer (God) and delivering a sermon (people)
- Adhere to the Baptist Churches of NSW & ACT "Statement of Belief"
- Provide the Roster Coordinator with availability of dates to serve
- Notify the Roster Coordinator of any inability to attend with as much notice as practicable

Prerequisites and/or skills required

- Church member, and/or agree with the "Responsibilities of Membership" listed in the Constitution (5.c.)
- Compliance with the Procedure for Staff and Volunteers (Category 2 b - Volunteers not in leadership roles or engaged in child-related work or work with vulnerable adults)
- Be a mature Christian, with the ability to maintain confidentiality
- Demonstrate love for prayer ministry

Supported by

- Church Leadership, and Church
- Service Leader
- Roster Coordinator

Term

- Appointed by the Roster Coordinator
- One year term, with eligibility for re-nomination for subsequent terms

Reporting to

- Roster Coordinator

Reporting method and frequency

- Verbally, as required
