Men's Ministry Team

Role Description

Be part of a team which supports the Men's Ministry Coordinator in the planning of men's ministries on behalf of the Church, in the Name of Jesus, reaching others in fellowship and outreach

Responsibilities

- To assist the Men's Ministry Coordinator to survey and identify the interests of the men within the Church
- To assist the Men's Ministry Coordinator in the planning, preparation and carrying out of ministries/events for which men in the Church have shown interest
- To encourage other men in the Church to attend and support the men's ministry
- To evangelise non-Christian men, through inviting and encouraging them to attend men's ministry events

Prerequisites and/or skills required

- Church member, and/or agree with the "Responsibilities of Membership" listed in the Constitution (5.c.)
- Compliance with the Procedure for Staff and Volunteers (Category 2 b - Volunteers not in leadership roles or engaged in child-related work or work with vulnerable adults)

Supported by

- Men's Ministry Coordinator
- Church Leadership, and Church
- Men's Ministry Team

Term

- Appointed by the Men's Ministry Coordinator
- One year term, with eligibility for re-appointment for subsequent terms

Reporting to

- Men's Ministry Coordinator

Reporting method and frequency

- By means of regular verbal reporting to the Men's Ministry Coordinator
