# THE SIX DAYS OF CREATION

The Gentile Calendar Begins With Genesis 1 . . . The Jewish Calendar Began With Exodus 12

Genesis 7:11; Genesis 8:4-5; Genesis 8:13-14

#### Genesis 1

#### JANUARY 1 – DAY AND NIGHT

1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. 2 And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the deep waters, and the Spirit of God moved upon them. 3 And God said, *Let there be light;* and there was light. 4 And God saw that the light was good: and God divided the light from the darkness. 5 And God called the light Day; and the darkness he called Night. **And the evening and morning were the first day.** 

#### JANUARY 2 - FIRMAMENT TO DIVIDE THE WATERS

6 And God said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters; and let it divide the waters from waters. 7 And God made the firmament, and divided the waters under the firmament from the waters above the firmament; and it was so. 8 And God called the firmament Heaven. **And the evening and morning were the second day.** 

#### JANUARY 3 - EARTH, SEAS, PLANTS AND TREES

9 And God said, Let the waters under the heaven be gathered together into one place, and let the dry land appear; and it was so. 10 And God called the dry land earth, and the gathering together of the waters he called seas; and God saw that it was good. 11 And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, and the herb yielding seed, and the tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed is in itself upon the earth; and it was so. 12 And the earth brought forth grass, and herb yielding seed after his kind, and the tree yielding fruit, whose seed was in itself, after his kind; and God saw that it was good. 13 And the evening and morning were the third day.

#### JANUARY 4 - Sun, Moon, and Stars

14 And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and for years. 15 And let the lights be for lights in the firmament of the heavens to give light upon the earth; and it was so. 16 And God made two great lights, the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night; he made the stars also. 17 And God set them in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth. 18 And the two great lights are to rule over the day and the night, and to divide the light from the darkness; and God saw that it was good. 19 And the evening and morning were the fourth day.

#### JANUARY 5 - FISH AND BIRDS

20 And God said, Let the waters bring forth abundantly the moving creatures that hath life, and the birds also, that they may fly above the earth in the open firmament of heaven. 21 And God created great whales, and every living creature that moves, which the waters brought forth abundantly, after their kind, and every winged bird after his kind; and God saw that it was good. 22 And God blessed them, saying, Be fruitful, and multiply, and fill the waters in the seas; and let birds multiply on the earth. [Genesis 2:19]. 23 And the evening and morning were the fifth day.

#### JANUARY 6 - ANIMALS, BUGS, AND MAN

24 And God said, Let the earth bring forth all the living creatures after his kind, the livestock, and creeping thing, and beast of the earth after his kind; and it was so. 25 And God made the beast of the earth after their kind, and the livestock after their kind, and everything that creeps upon the earth after his kind; and God saw that it was good. 26 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness; and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the birds of the air, and over the livestock, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps upon the earth. 27 Thus God created man in his own image; male and female created he them. 28 And God blessed mankind [both men and women], and said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it; and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves upon the earth. 29 And God said unto them, Behold, I have given you every herb bearing seed upon the face of all the earth, and upon every tree in which is the fruit of the tree that yields its seed; and unto you it shall be for meat. 30 And to every beast of the earth, and to every bird of the air, and to everything that creeps upon the face of the earth, wherever therein is life have I given every green herb for meat; and it was so. [Genesis 9:3-4]. 31 And God saw everything that he had made, and behold, it was very good. And the evening and morning were the sixth day.
