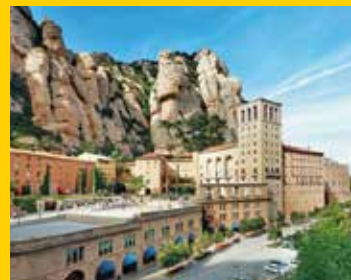
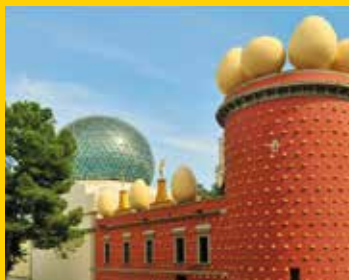
UNFORGETTABLE, IMMERSIVE BARCELONA EXPERIENCE

**BARCELONA ADVENTURES: FEBRUARY TO MAY 2022**

LifeAdventures is developing custom trips which bring together 20-25 MIT alums, family, and friends for stays in Barcelona, Spain for 2 weeks or 1 month with optional extensions of 30 and 60 days. These trips aim to bring together folks on vacation for two weeks as well as remote workers and retirees who are not time constrained and can enjoy a longer stay in.

We are providing a customized, flexible program, with 8-10 activities included for the 2-week adventurers and 2-3 activities per week for those staying longer. Optional mini courses and excursions as well as lots of time to explore Barcelona at your own pace are available.

We will engage with local MIT alumni in multiple settings, socially as well as inviting alums to give talks to our group on the work that they are doing.



## BASICS

- Airport pickup / drop-off
- Stay in furnished apartments
- Participate in sightseeing activities more in depth and in smaller groups (6-8 folks per guide)
- Meet all events at a specified location
- Meals only provided as part of included activities
- Pick and choose from several optional activities
- Local ambassador helps to coordinate activities and handle any issues that arise
- Extend 30-day option to 60 or 90 days within 7 days of returning home (may need to change apartment)
- Private Facebook group available for those interested in Barcelona trip(s)
- Pre-trip and post-trip Zoom get togethers
- Follow Covid safe guidelines



## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- No visa is required for US/EU/U citizens staying in Spain for up to 90 days.
- Passport should be valid for up to 3 months beyond your stay

- Stay in furnished apartments or aparthotels
- Choose from 2-3 neighborhoods (City Center, Poble Nou, Gracia, Sant Antoni)
- Include kitchenette and WIFI
- Close to Metro stations

- All about Dali, Miro, or Picasso
- Jewish Heritage (lecture + guided sightseeing)
- Gastronomy (restaurants frequented by locals, tapas tour, sweets tour)
