CNA (Certified Nursing Assistant) provides basic care and assistance with daily living activities under the direct supervision of a licensed nurse (RN or LVN). They help patients with bathing, grooming, dressing, toileting, eating, and mobility. CNAs measure and record vital signs (blood pressure, temperature, pulse, respiration), keep patients clean and comfortable, maintain a safe environment, serve meals, observe and report changes in patient condition, collect routine specimens such as urine or stool, and document the care they provide.
