LVN (Licensed Vocational Nurse) can perform simple as well as complex medical procedures but must operate under the supervision of a registered nurse (RN). They can administer some medications, monitor patient response to medications, implement wound care, perform vital sign measurements (blood pressure, heart rate, pain management, temperature, rehabilitation, oxygen saturation, etc), maintain patient records, and collect blood and urine samples for lab testing. They may also perform simple lab diagnostic procedures like urinalysis. Total program hours: 1570
