We acknowledge that every child, young person, or adult who plays or participates in football should be able to do so in an enjoyable and safe environment.

It is our responsibility to our club members, visiting teams and referees, that all are protected from poor practice and all forms of abuse.

Dawes Hernhill Herons FC will not tolerate any form of inappropriate language or threatening behaviour from players, parents, spectators, visitors, officials, or club representatives.

All spectators must adhere to the FA Respect Campaign and always remain behind any designated spectator barrier (Respect Line). Non-players may only enter the field of play with clear invitation from the referee.

Dawes Hernhill Herons FC reserves the right to ask any individual demonstrating actions deemed to be against this policy: to move away from pitch-side, and if necessary, leave the Club premises. Any such need will also result in Dawes Hernhill Herons FC reporting both the individual and their associated club to the relevant controlling Footballing Organisation and the police if necessary.
