EL PASO COUNTY REPUBLICAN ASSEMBLY – MARCH 21, 2026

Pursuant to the Bylaws of the El Paso County Republican Central Committee, and Colorado Revised Statutes § 1-4-601 and § 1-4-602, notice is hereby given that the **El Paso County Republican Assembly** shall be convened beginning at **9:00 am on March 21, 2026 at Sand Creek High School**, located at 7005 Carefree Cir. N Colorado Springs, CO 80922. Check-in and credentialing for this Assembly will begin at 7:00 am.

A total of **1492 delegates and 1492 alternate delegates** have been authorized by the Central Committee of the El Paso County Republican Party for this Assembly, which delegates and alternate delegates have been apportioned to each precinct according to the votes cast in each precinct for the Republican candidate for President in the last general election, as described on our website (gopelpaso.com) under the Caucus Tap “Delegate Allocations”.

The principal purposes of this Assembly of county delegates shall be:

- To ratify the election of precinct committeepersons;
- To designate Republican candidate(s) for the County offices;
- To ratify the election of delegates and alternates to the Colorado State Republican Assembly.
- To accept standing rules and vote on County Resolutions from Caucus. We will also conduct all other business of the Republican Party, that may lawfully come before such an Assembly of delegates.

Notice is also given on behalf of the respective District Chairman that the following single-county Republican District Assemblies shall be convened in connection with this County Assembly for the purpose of designating Republican candidates to the 2026 Primary Election ballot, and delegates and alternates to the El Paso County Republican Assembly residing in such District shall serve in their respective capacities to such District Assemblies:

County Commissioner Districts #1 and #5
State Representative Districts #14, #15, #16, #17, #20, #21, and #22
State Senatorial Districts #9, and #11
