Civil Rights Complaint Procedure

For the Child Nutrition Programs

SFA: Family Worship Christian Academy

Purpose:

To ensure **all individuals** have equal access to participate in the USDA Child Nutrition Programs at Family Worship Christian Academy, and to provide a formal process for addressing any **civil rights complaints** alleging discrimination based on:

- Race
- Color
- National Origin
- Sex (including gender identity and sexual orientation)
- Age
- Disability
- Reprisal or retaliation for prior civil rights activity

Complaint Process Overview

1. How to File a Complaint

Anyone who believes they or someone else has been **discriminated against** in any school food service activity may file a civil rights complaint.

Complaints may be:

- Written
- Verbal

- In-person or via phone
- **Anonymous** (though limited investigation may occur)

Complaints can be submitted to the school or directly to USDA.

2. Receiving the Complaint

All school staff must:

- Take all complaints seriously
- Immediately report the complaint to the Civil Rights Coordinator (see contact below)
- Maintain **confidentiality** throughout the process

3. Information to Collect (If Possible)

A written or verbal complaint should include:

- Complainant's name, address, and phone number (if provided)
- The specific location and program where the incident occurred
- The basis of the alleged discrimination (race, age, etc.)
- The nature of the incident or action
- Names and titles of those involved
- Date(s) of the alleged discrimination
- A written or verbal description of what happened

4. Forwarding the Complaint

All civil rights complaints must be forwarded within 5 calendar days to:

5. Local Documentation

The SFA must:

- Keep a log of all complaints received, even if forwarded to USDA
- Maintain confidentiality of all complaint records
- Ensure no retaliation against anyone who files a complaint

A Reminder

This procedure applies only to civil rights complaints related to USDA Child Nutrition Programs. Other types of grievances or school-related concerns should be directed through the school's general complaint or disciplinary procedures.
