- **Pollination Requirement:** Almost all apple trees are not self-pollinating and require a partner (a different variety).
- **Ideal Distance:** Plant trees within 50 feet of each other for optimal cross-pollination. While they can be up to 100 feet apart, closer is generally better.
- **Bloom Time Matching:** Select varieties that bloom at the same time (early, mid, or late season) to ensure they can pollinate each other.
