OFFICIAL RULES



CATEGORY	OFFICIAL RULE
 Official Equipment	Bounce PRO™ may only be played using an official Bounce PRO™ rebounder.
 Ball	An official Size 5 football (soccer ball) is recommended for all matches.
 Players	Matches may be played as Singles (1 vs. 1), Doubles (2 vs. 2), or Teams (3 vs. 3).
 Match Format	A match consists of the best of three (3) sets.
 15 Scoring	Each set is played to 15 points. A player or team must win by 2 points.
 Service Attempts	Each player or team is allowed one (1) service attempt per point.
 Service Contact	The serve must be made with one touch using any legal body part, except the hands and arms.
 Service Rotation	1V1 The winner of each rally serves the next point. 2v2 and 3v3 Player Rotation Players rotate positions after each service. Winner of each rally serv the next point
 10 FT Service Position	The server must stand 10 feet (3.05 m) from the Bounce PRO™ rebounder when serving.
 Maximum Touches	1v1 - Each player may use up to three (3) touches to return the ball off the Bounce PRO™ rebounder. 2v2 Options 1: The receiving player has up to 2 touches to control the ball and pass it to their teammate. The teammate then has 1 touch to return the ball off the Bounce Pro Rebounder. 2v2 Option 2 - Each player may use one (1) touch at a time. The ball may be returned off the Bounce PRO™ rebounder on the 1st, 2nd and 3rd touch. 3V3 -Each player on the team must touch the ball once before it is returned off the Bounce PRO™ rebounder.
 EQUIPMENT Contact	The ball can contact the Bounce PRO™ rebound surface anywhere before crossing the CTR line onto the opposing side.
 Hands & Arms	Contact with the hands or arms is strictly prohibited.
 Equipment Contact	Players may not touch the Bounce PRO™ frame or rebound surface during a rally. If the ball strikes the Bounce PRO™ frame and rebounds upward and forward in the same direction of play, the ball remains live.
 Frame Contact	If the ball strikes the Bounce PRO™ frame and rebounds backward or in the opposite direction, the ball is out, and the point is awarded to the opposing player or team. If the ball strikes the Bounce PRO™ frame and does not rebound upward or forward into playable space, the point is lost.
 Winning the Match	The first player or team to win two (2) sets wins the match.
 Unique Playing Surface	The Bounce PRO™ string rebound surface delivers a faster, higher, and more dynamic rebound, allowing for a broader range of technical skills, athletic movements, and creative shot-making than traditional rebound sports.

LINE REQUIREMENTS

Proper line setup ensures fair play and consistent game standards.



CTR LINE

The center (CTR) line must be perpendicular to the panel and centered on the **Bounce PRO™** rebound surface.



SERVICE LINES

The service lines must be parallel to the center line, **10 feet (3.05 m)** from each side edge of the panel.



SERVICE DISTANCE

Players must stand **behind the service line** when serving.



IMPORTANT

All lines must be clearly visible and distinct. Use tape, paint, or other approved marking methods.



KEY RULE

The server must stand **10 feet (3.05 m)** from the panel behind the service line when serving the ball.
