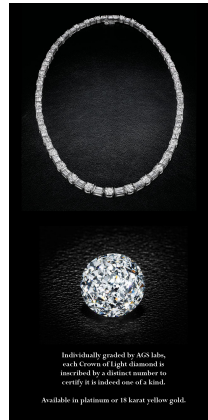


Image 6 – The million-dollar Crown of Light diamond necklace
