### **COVID-19 Vaccines and the "New Normal" Webinar**

Organised by YASHK in partnership with The Hong Kong Academy for Gifted Education (HKAGE) and The Hong Kong Young Industrialists Council (HKYIC), an online webinar, titled *COVID-19 Vaccines and the "New Normal"*, was conducted on 27 March 2021. In this webinar, YASHK members Prof. Benjamin COWLING and Prof. Leo POON, as well as Prof. Angela WU of HKUST, elucidated the different types of COVID-19 vaccines and discussed the "New Normal" that may follow even after vaccination. Moderated by YASHK member Prof. Anderson SHUM, the webinar attracted 250 real-time participants and 4000 views of the recorded video on social media platforms.

# **YASHK Eligible to Vote in the Elections**

With the passage of Improving the Electoral System of Hong Kong in May 2021, YASHK, as well as its mother organisation ASHK, has been enlisted as one of the specified entities eligible to be registered as voters in the new Election Committee Subsector and Legislative Council Functional Constituency of Technology and Innovation. 2021 Election Committee Subsector Election and 2021 Legislative Council Election will be held on 19 September 2021 and 19 December 2021 respectively.

# **City I&T Grand Challenge Star Workshop**

Prof. Lap-Chee TSUI, President of ASHK, and Prof. Vic LAW, President of YASHK, were invited as star speakers in the City Innovation and Technology (I&T) Grand Challenge Star Workshop on 25 March 2021 at Hong Kong Science Park. In the workshop, they were engaged in a dialogue on how science and technology play a fundamental role in today's world and discussed the global I&T ecology amid the "New Normal" following the pandemic.

#### Joint Talk Series with HKAGE

Led by the Outreach Committee Chair Prof. Stephanie MA, the 6<sup>th</sup> session of the Talk Series on Emerging Technologies: Science, Opportunities and Challenges, co-organised with HKAGE, was held on 16 January 2021. Titled "Revolutionising Drug Discovery Through In-Silico Design", the session was given by YASHK member Prof. Xuhui HUANG and Prof. Hongzhe SUN of HKU. The talk attracted an audience of 117 high school students and teachers.

In Spring 2021, a series of three talks were held in partnership with Hong Kong Science Museum, in addition to HKAGE, as an event of HK SciFest. In this series, the talks set out the themes of 1) *Cosmology* delivered by YASHK member Prof. Hua-Bai LI and Prof. Yi WANG of HKUST on 27 March 2021, 2) *COVID-19* by YASHK member Prof. Leo POON on 3 April 2021, and 3) *Environment and Sustainability* by YASHK members Prof. Amos TAI and Prof. Yi-Chun LU on 10 April 2021. Each talk attracted an average of nearly 150 participants, including secondary school students and teachers.
